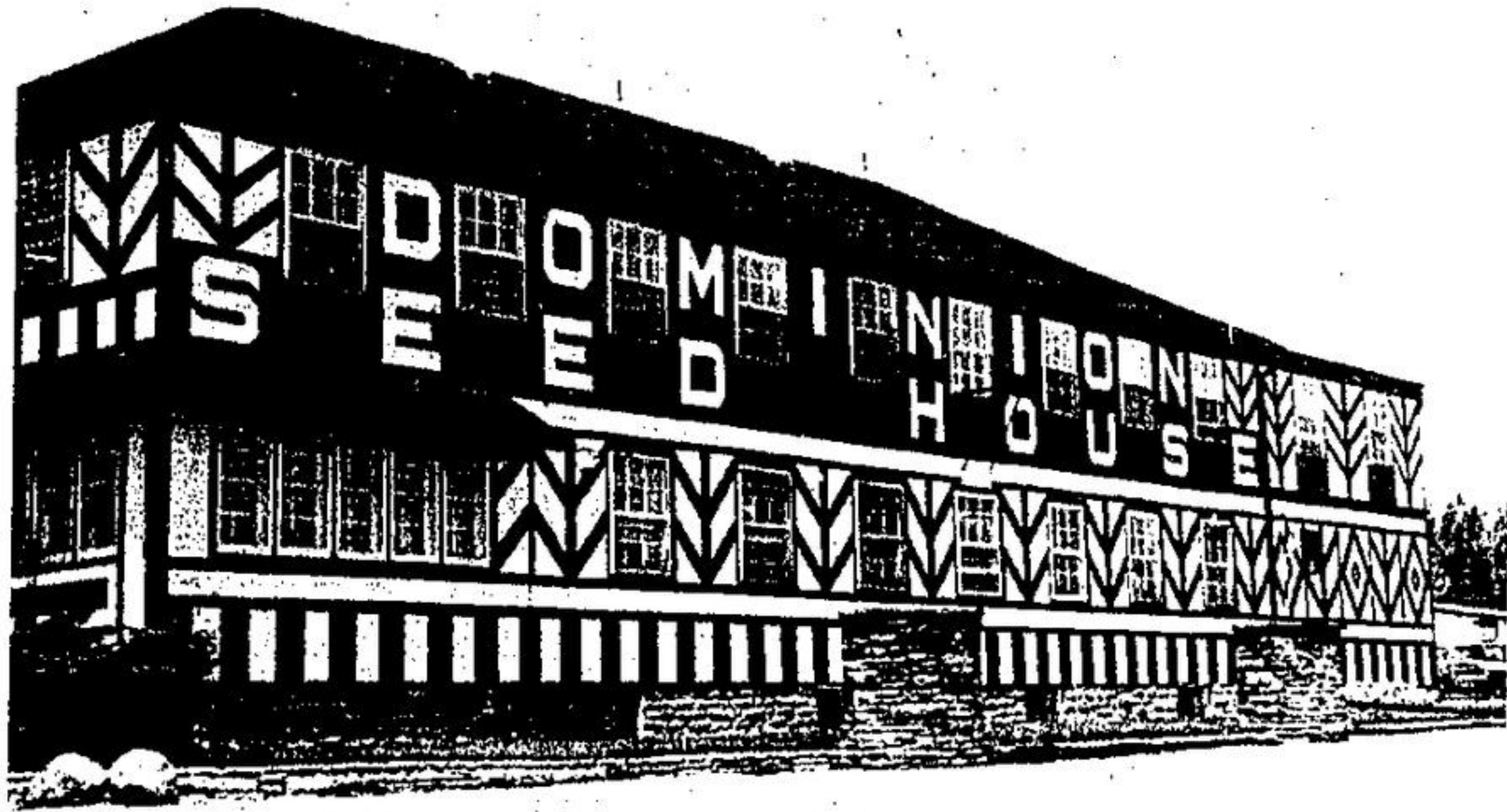
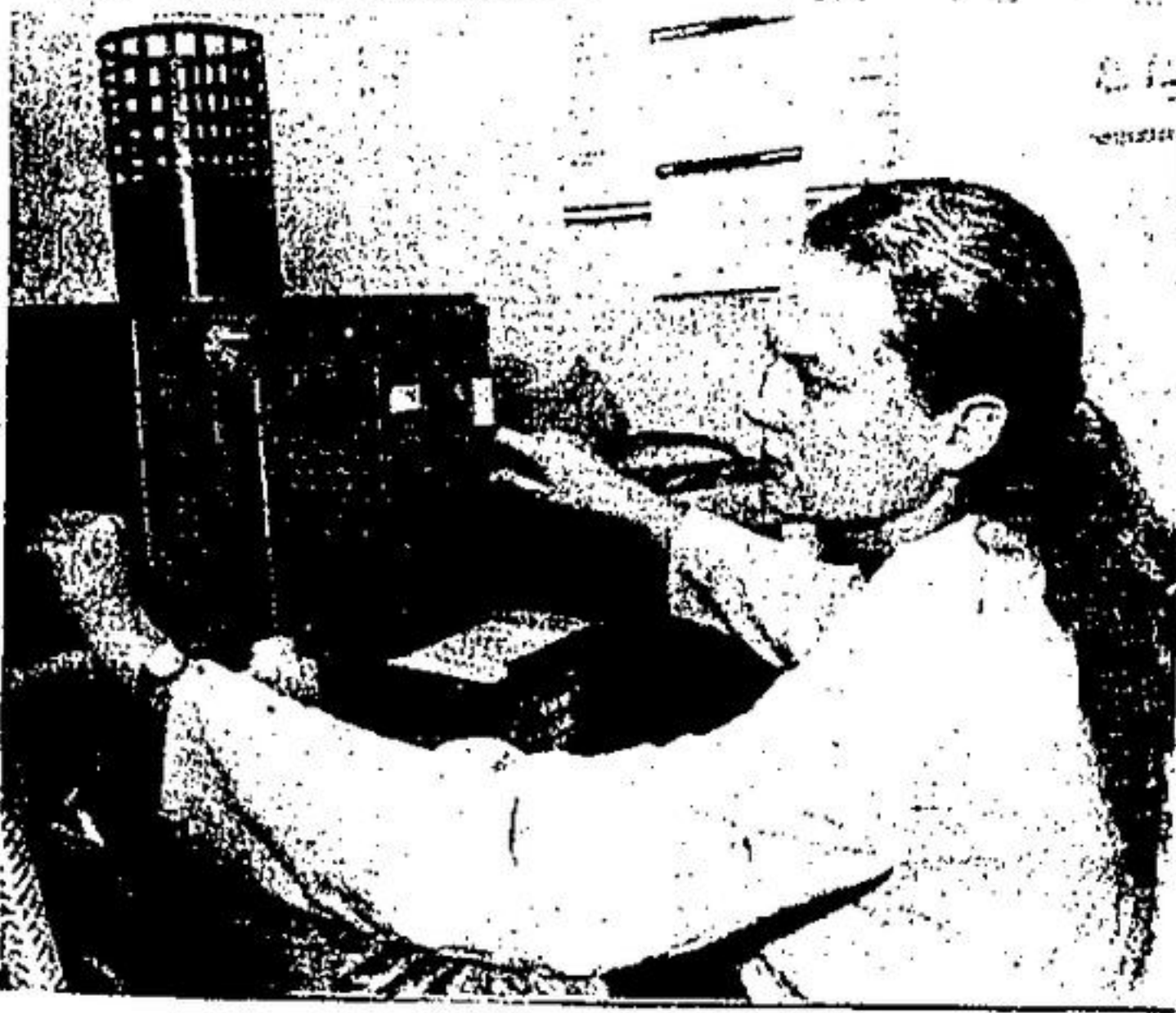

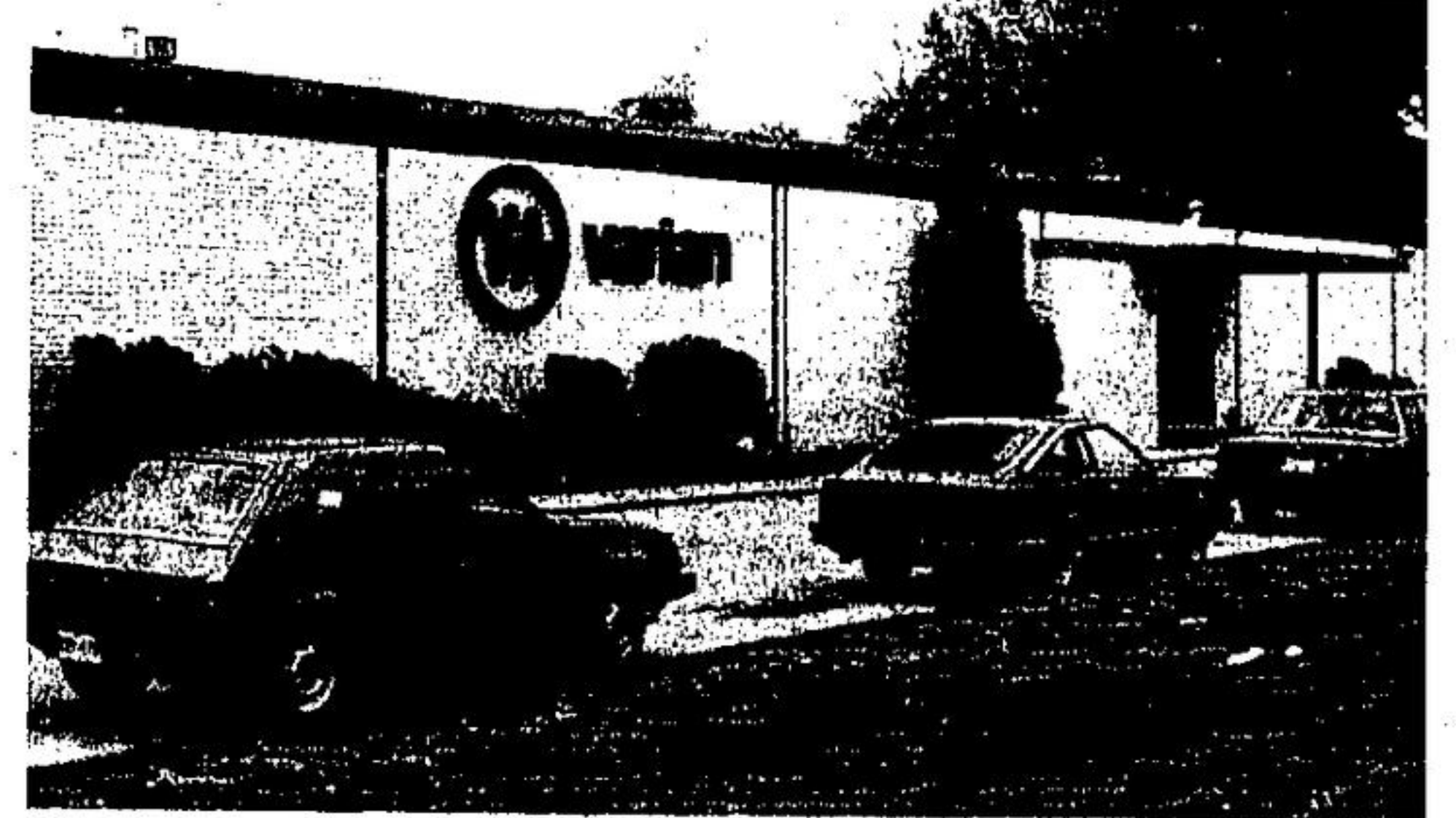
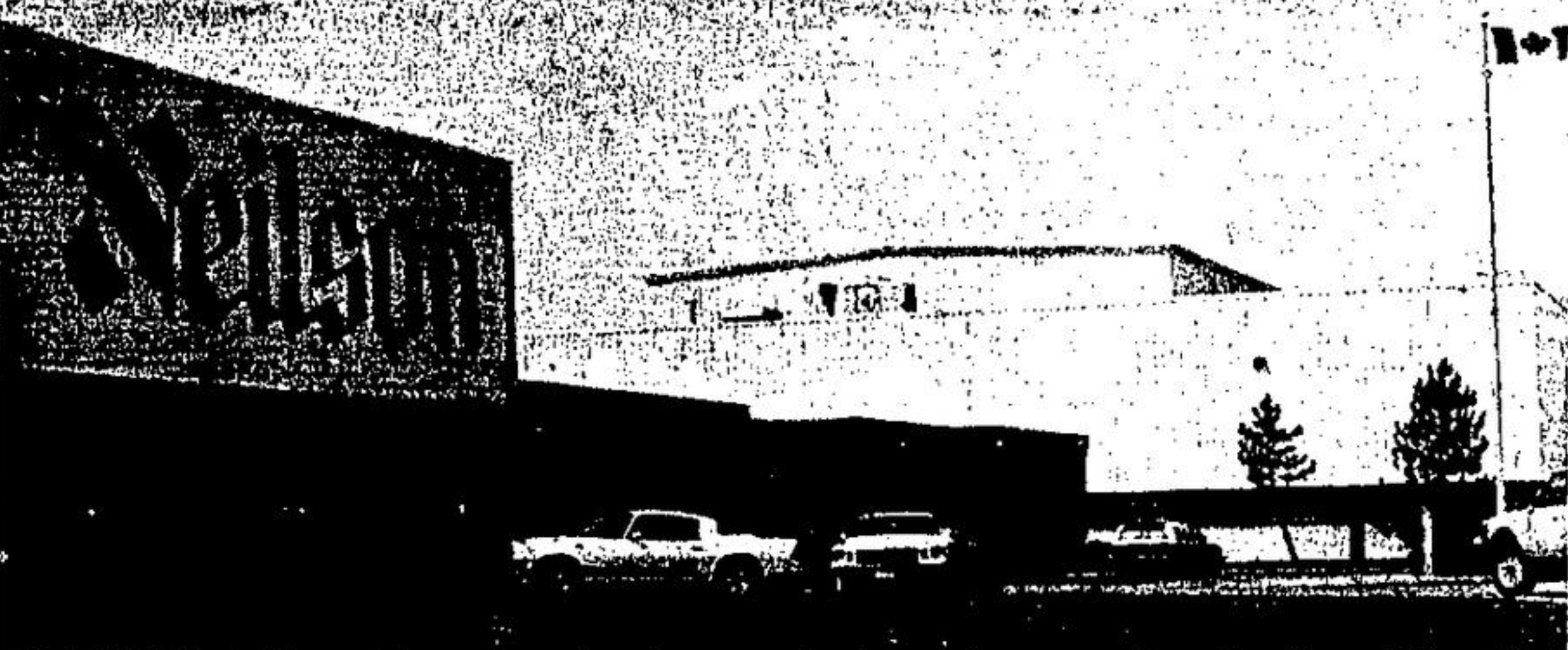
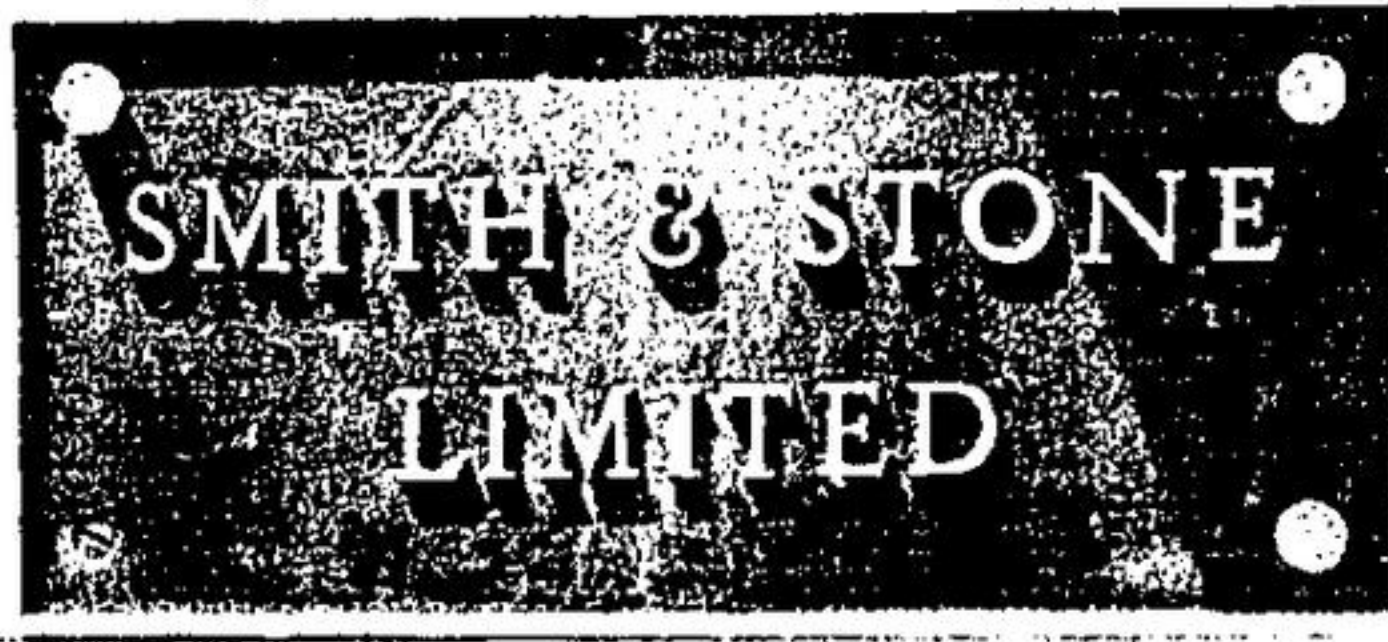

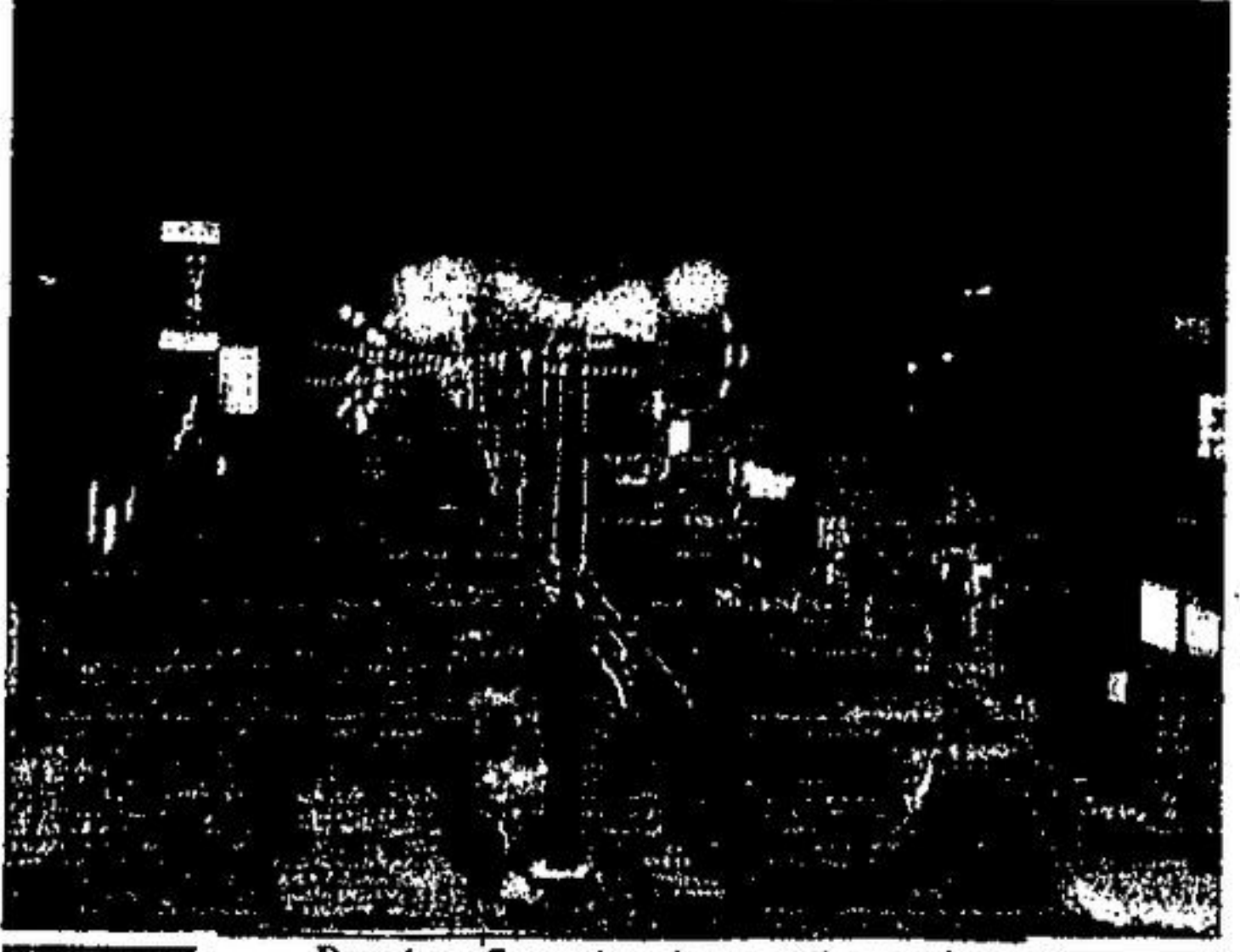
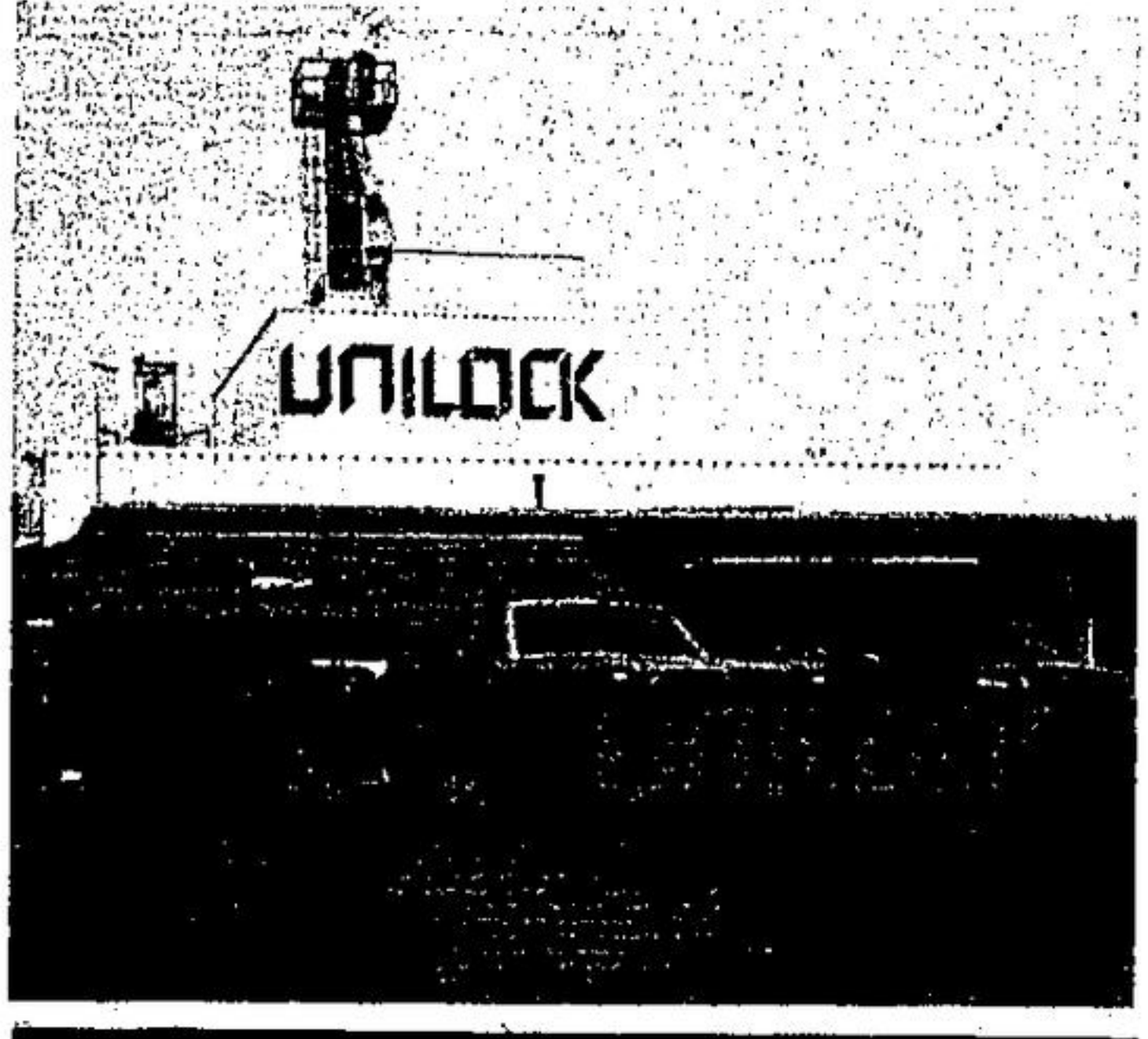
Research at the Maple Leaf Mills testing centre is helping farmers produce higher yields.



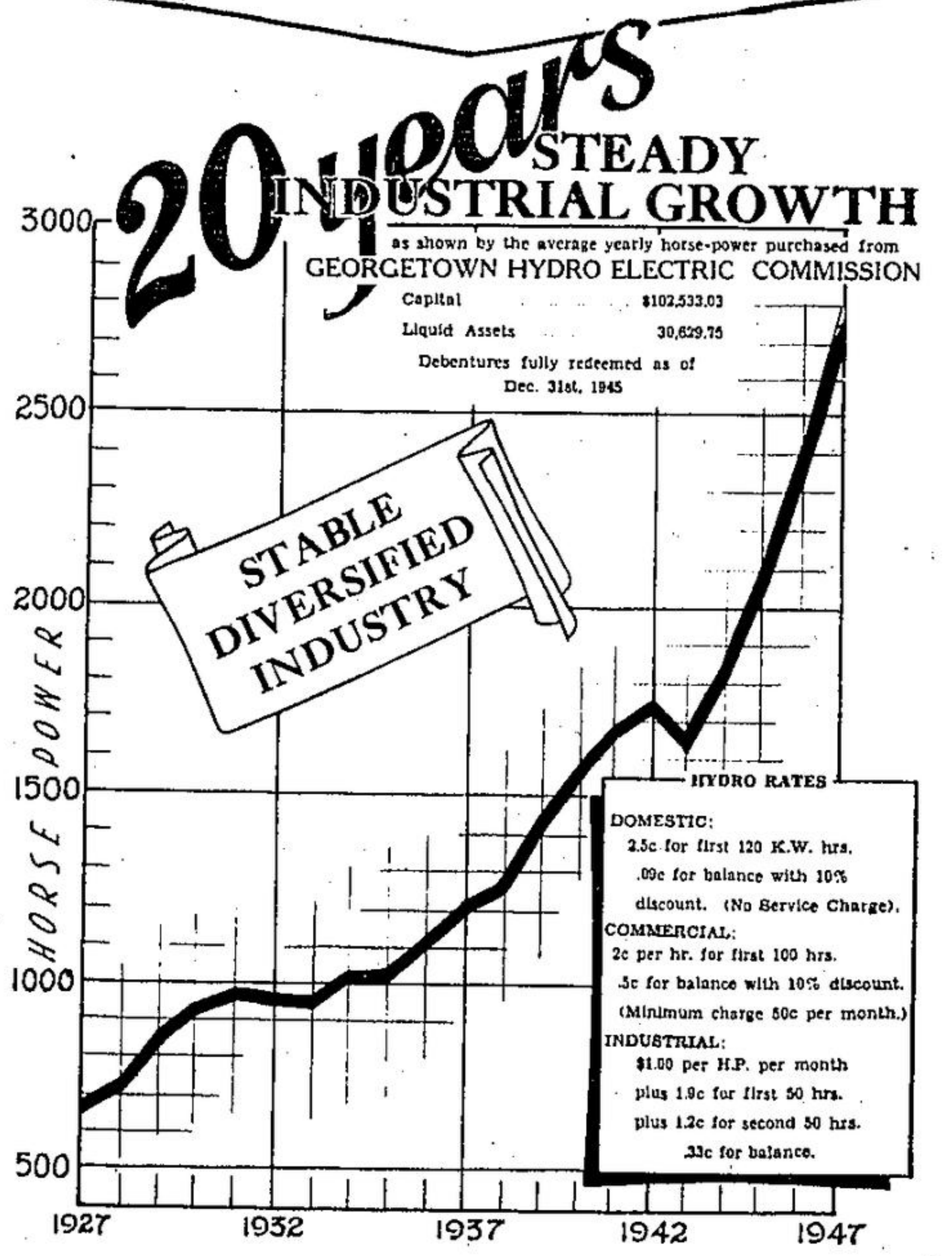
The latest winner in the Lions' Georgetown Citizen of the Year was Ralph Urael.
