Cedarvale trails?

The recreation department would like to increase its trails at Silvercreek. Summer students will be studying the properties adjoining Silvercreek and finding out who owns them and what are the possibilities for the town acquiring them.

Forecasting only

After spending a considerable amount of time and money preparing a capital forecast for the town to 1988 inclusive, it was also added that the forecast isn't carved in stone.

Region will allow study

The next step in choosing a landfill site for the region's garbage will cost approximately \$409,084. The second phase of the site selection study got the regional go-ahead last week when councillors authorized regional chairman Peter Pomeroy to sign an agreement with Walker Wright Young Associates Ltd. to undertake the project.

Saving for complex

Council's budget committee hasn't given up totally on a municipal administration building for the town.

The project is listed as a \$1 million debenture for next year.

More parking at Cedarvale

A second entrance to Cedarvale Park is in the recreation department's planning books.

Recreation department director Tom Shepard indicated a \$20,000 expenditure next year to create a second entrance

and parking lot for Cedarvale Park.

The proposal was included in the five year capital forecast for the town, presented Monday night to town councillors. Councillors have the final say next year
