Meeting Orangeville the first period remained scoreless.

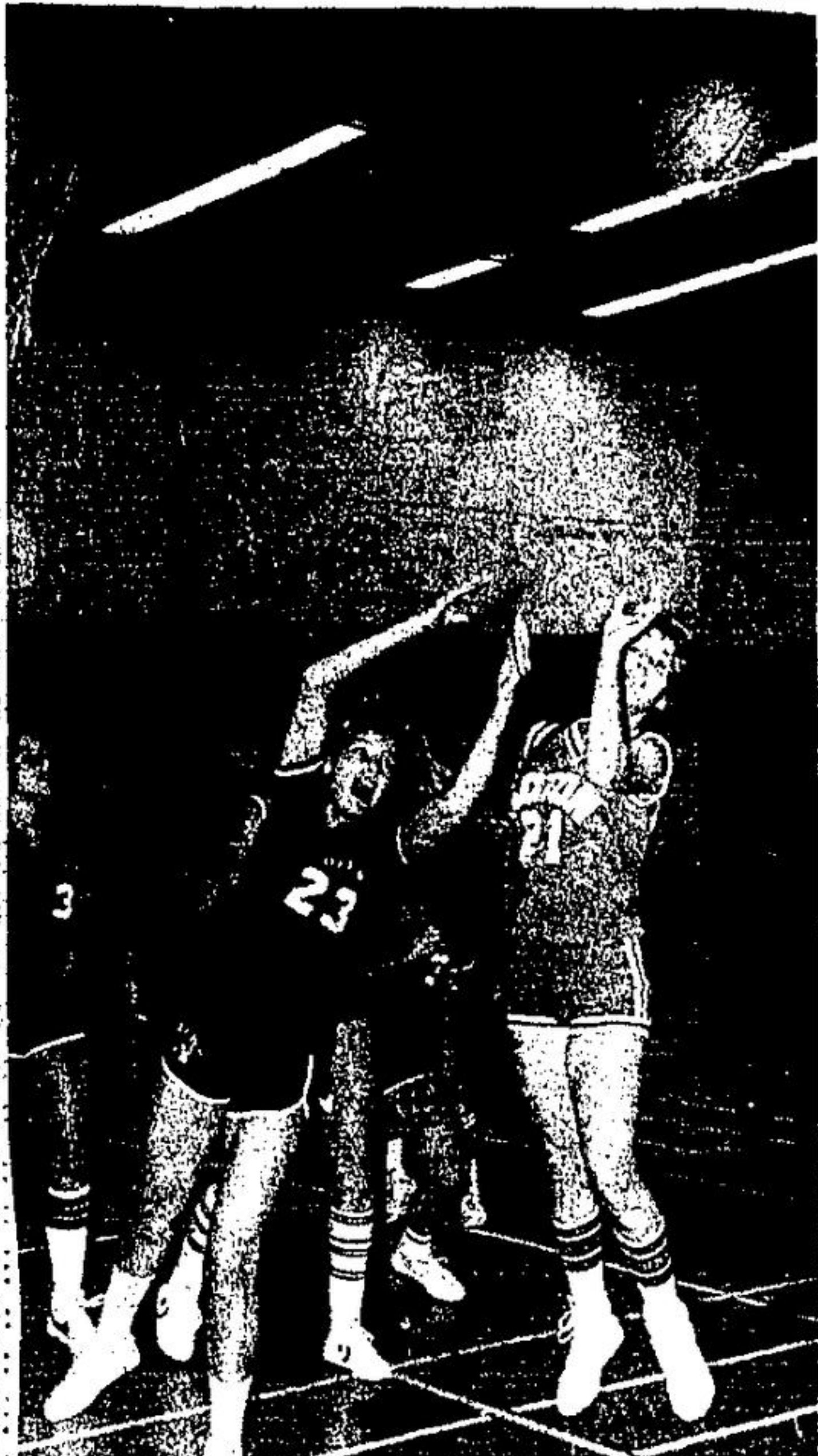
