Tears and smiles like us He knew.

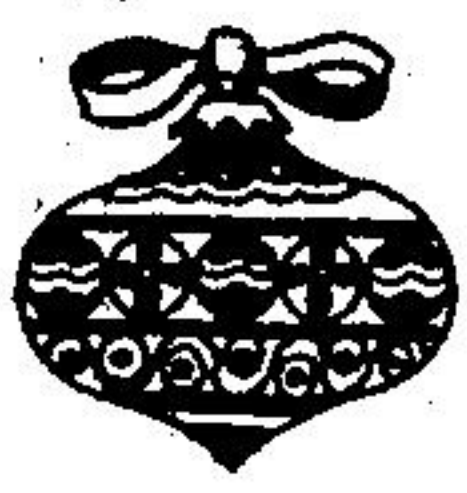
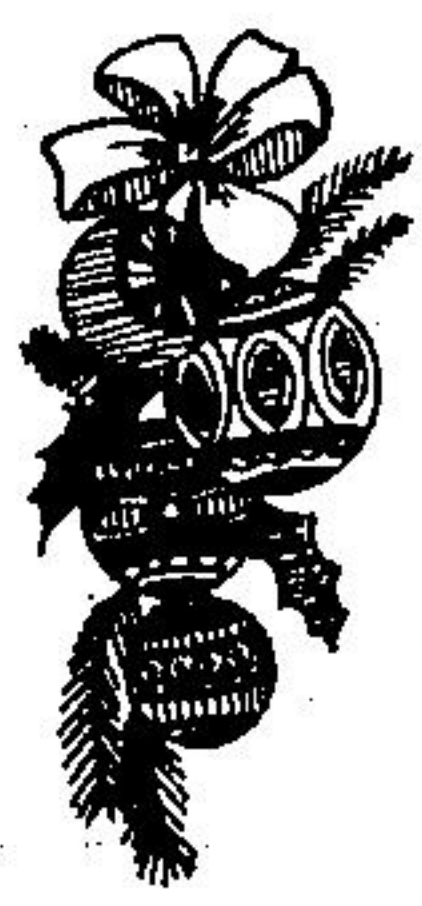
And He feelth for our sadness,
