

Christmas cookbook

LEMON VELVET PUDDING
3 eggs, separated
Grated rind of 1 large lemon
One-third cup fresh lemon juice
¼ tsp. salt
1 cup sugar
One-third cup cornstarch
1 cup water
1 tsp. butter
1 cup heavy cream, whipped
1 dozen Ladyfingers
Beat egg whites until stiff; beat yolks until thick. Add lemon rind and juice to yolks, mix dry ingredients. Gradually stir in water. Stir into egg yolks and cook over low heat, stirring constantly, until thick and smooth, remove from heat, add butter, and stir until melted. Fold in egg whites. Let stand until cool. Fold in whipped cream. Pour into glass bowl lined with

Ladyfingers, chill. Makes 6 servings.

SWEDISH ALMOND TARTS
2 cups sifted all-purpose flour
½ tsp. salt
1 tsp. sugar
1 tsp. baking powder
¾ cup butter or margarine
1 egg yolk
2 tsp. Brandy
Raspberry Jam
Almond filling
Sift flour, salt, sugar and baking powder; cut in butter. Add egg yolk and Brandy; blend well. Chill, roll out dough ¼" thick. Butter eight 4-inch fluted tart pans and line with rounds of dough. Roll remaining dough and cut into ½" strips. Place 2 tsp. Raspberry Jam in each unbaked tart shells. Fill ¾ full with

Almond filling. Arrange 2 strips of pastry on top to form a cross. Bake in preheated slow oven (325°F), for about 30 minutes.

RUM & RAISIN CHEESECAKE
Crust:
1 cup graham cracker crumbs
3 tsp. sugar
½ tsp. cinnamon

3 tbsp. margarine, melted.
Filling:
3 - 8 oz. pkgs. cream cheese
¼ cup sugar
½ cup flour divided
2 eggs
¼ cup rum
1 cup finely shredded carrot
¼ cup raisins
½ tsp. nutmeg
½ tsp. ginger

Preheat oven to 325°. Make crust as follows - combine crumbs, sugar, cinnamon and margarine, press into the bottom of a 9"

springform pan. Bake 10 mins. Remove from oven and set aside. Increase oven to 450°. Filling as follows: Combine two packages cream cheese, sugar and ¼ cup flour, mix at medium speed until well blended. Add eggs one at a time, mixing well after each addition. Blend in rum and carrots, raisins, remaining flour and spices. Pour into the crust and bake 10 mins. Reduce oven temperature to 250° and continue baking for 55 mins. Loosen cake from rim of pan, cool before

removing rim. For the topping combine remaining ¼ pkg. of cream cheese, 2 tsp. rum, 2½ cups icing sugar and mix well. Add the icing sugar very slowly. Pour over the cheesecake and decorate with a few raisins.

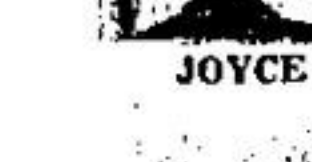
