

### Computer credits

Halton Hills TV viewers can earn a college credit at home this winter when Sheridan College televises a computer course.

"The New Literacy - An Introduction to Computers" will be aired over Halton Cable TV in Georgetown and Acton beginning the week of Feb. 3.

The 13-week (26 half-hour segments) computer-readiness course provides students with a foundation for later 'hands-on' use, according to Sheridan College Distance Education Dean Peter Mallett. The course presents an overview of computer applications in the work environment, and computer language.

Four group meetings with an instructor, as well as a telephone tutoring service, augment the TV sessions.

### Two taxi applications

Two Georgetown men have applied for taxi cab owner's licenses from the town.

Monday night, the applications of Kenneth Shaw of River Drive and Cecil Kyle of Lindsay Court received initial approval.

Final approval is due at next week's council meeting.

The two are to work out of the Halton Hills Taxi office, which holds a broker's license.

There are currently 15 taxi cab licenses operating, of a total 25 available from the town.

Clerk administrator Ken Richardson said the figure of 25 licenses was established many years ago, on the ratio of one cab per 1,000 population. Halton Hills' population is now 35,000.

### Garbage under study

Peel Region officials are putting the finishing touches on a key report to examine garbage disposal by landfill, incineration and recycling. Chief administrative officer Rick Frost said the report should be ready by February and added public meetings about the different proposals will start this spring.

"This report will be a complete summary of where we stand on landfill, incineration, and recycling," said Mr. Frost.

Peel Region wants to close the Britannia Road dump in Mississauga by 1990 and reduce the amount of garbage sent to landfill by 60 per cent by 1990. Fifty per cent of garbage will be sent to incineration, with the remaining 10 per cent going to four community recycling centres.

Mr. Frost said the report will include the results of a study carried out recently at a proposed landfill site in north-west Brampton near Georgetown.

Residents of north-west Brampton have formed the Concerned Citizens of Brampton to fight the dump proposal. "Our report will also include the comments by citizens' groups," said Mr. Frost.

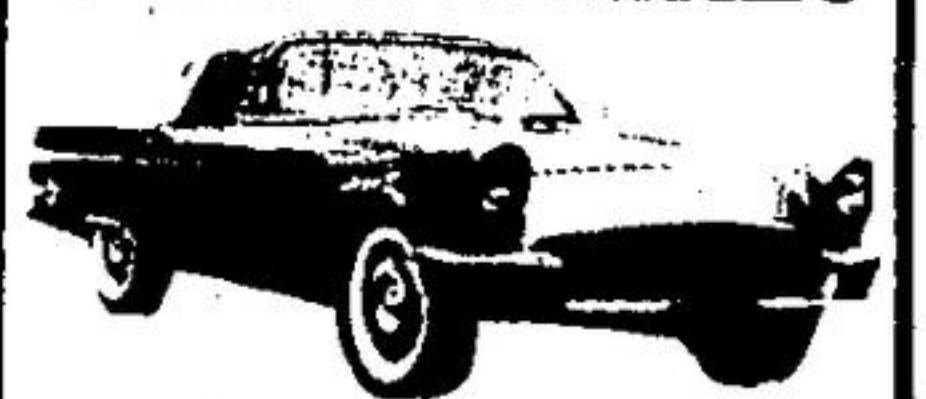
