Garbage under study

Peel Region officials are putting the finishing touches on a key report to examine garbage disposal by landfill, incineration and recycling. Chief administrative officer Rick Frost said the report should be ready by February and added public meetings about the different proposals will start this

spring. "This report will be a complete summary of where we stand on landfill, incineration, and recycling," said Mr. Frost.

Peel Region wants to close the Britannia Road dump in Mississauga by 1990 and reduce the amount of garbage sent to landfill by 60 per cent by 1990. Fifty per cent of garbage will be sent to incineration, with the remaining 10 per cent going to four community recycling centres.

. Mr. Frost said the report will include the results of a study carried out recently at a proposed landfill site in northwest Brampton near Georgetown. Residents of north-

west Brampton have formed the Concerned Citizens of Brampton to fight the dump proposal.
"Our report will also include the comments by citizens' groups," said Mr. Frost.


