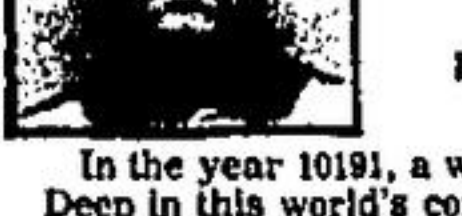

## Report naming Halton \$91,000 grant dump site postponed for libraries

It seems almost like a play to build suspense, but the report naming the region's next garbage dump wasn't released last week as expected.

Instead, consultants Walker, Wright, Young Associates Ltd. asked for an extension to Feb. 8, to make public their choice of six possible sites in the region.

Residents near the proposed sites being studied over the past year were left holding their breath at the region's solid waste management

committee meeting Jan. 14, as councillors granted the extension.  
The reason for the extension is to allow the consultants time to review data released by the Ontario Waste Management Commission (OWMC) Jan. 9.

The Commission is looking for a dump site for its toxic liquid industrial wastes. Two of its

sites are the same as those being studied by the region for municipal garbage.

The region's director of planning and development said that the region's position is to remain independent of the OWMC process, but that their (Commission's) reports must be reviewed to be sure the process is complete and thorough.

The libraries of Halton Hills, Milton and Oakville received a \$91,000 grant to help upgrade their automated record keeping system.

The announcement was made last week by the Ministry of Citizenship and Culture.

"The grant will now allow the co-operative to complete its first step in a phased plan to introduce an on-line catalogue," said Susan Fish, the

minister responsible for the funding.  
"Halinet was formed in 1980 to create and operate an automated system that would control the record keeping in Halton Hills, Milton and Oakville public libraries," she said.

Library Co-operative Automation Program (LCAP) is a \$1.2 million program designed to promote development of local library networks.
