There are five categories of scholarship for which persons may apply. Projects such as the Felix Posaak show at the John Elliott Theatre March 23 helps to fund the special scholarships.

The scholarships provide the funds for one academic year of study abroad. If you are interested in applying for one of these scholarships, or want more information call 877-4078. The five Rotary Found-

ation Scholarships available are:

—Graduate - for those who will have received a bachelor's degree or its equivalent before the commencement of scholarship studies.

—Undergraduate - for those studying at the university level who will not have completed their bachelor's degree before commencement of

scholarship studies.

—Vocational - for those secondary school graduates who have been employed or engaged full-time in a vocation for at least two years as of the application deadline. Cannot be eligible for the first two scholarships.

—Teacher of the Handicapped - for those

employed or engaged as full-time teachers of the physically, mentally or educationally handicapped for at least two years.

—Journalism - for those employed full time in print or broadcast journalism for at least two years and who intend to continue their career after completion of scholarship studies.

Hamlet meeting about housing

A proposal to build homes in Silver Creek is up again for town council's approval.

Rostrevor Developments Limited wants to build 16 estate homes on a cul-de-sac road northeast of existing homes along Trafalgar Road on Sideroad 27.

Originally submitted in October 1977, the proposal has been awaiting completion of the Niagara Escarpment Plan and the Halton Hills Official Plan.

According to the Official Plan, the 34 acres are designated "rural cluster" and non-farm residential development is encouraged there.

Under the Niagara Escarpment Commission plan, Silver Creek is recognized as a "minor urban centre" which permits such development.

As long as the developer doesn't build structures within a small easterly portion of the property which is designated "natural area" and has the most restrictions, the Commission has no objections to the proposal.

The town's director of planning makes some design recommendations for the planner, but otherwise supports holding a public meeting on the proposal.

Councillors decided to hold a public meeting next month, inviting comments on the proposal.
