Hamlet meeting about housing

Herald Staff A proposal to build homes in Silver Creek is up again for town council's approval.

Rostrevor Developments Limited wants to build 16 estate homes on a cul-de-sac road northeast of existing homes along Trafalgar Road on Sideroad 27.

Originally submitted in October 1977, the proposal has been awaiting completion of the Niagara Escarpment Plan and the Halton Hills Official Plan.

According to the Official Plan, the 34 acres are designated "rural cluster" and non-farm residential development is encouraged there. Under the Niagara

Escarpment Commission plan, Silver Creek is recognized as a "minor urban centre" which permits such development. As long as the develop-

er doesn't build structures within a small easterly portion of the property which is designated "natural area" and has the most restrictions, the Commission has no objections to the proposal.

The town's director of planning makes some design recommendations for the planner, but otherwise supports holding a public meeting on the proposal.

Councillors decided to hold a public meeting next month, inviting comments on the propo-


