GDHS math kids receive top status

The Grade 9 Georgetown District High School math team placed 39th overall in Canada out of the 1,162 schools competing.

The top three students who formed the school team for scoring purposes were Lorelei Smith, David Chatten and Lisa Walters who recorded a team score of 398.25 out of a possible 450 points.

That score provided the team with Canadian and Ontario Honor Roll status.

Lorelei Smith tied for first in Halton and second in Halton-Peel with a score of 143.75 out of a possible 150 points.

She also placed 47th in Canada and 22nd in the Ontario standings.

GDHS Grade 9 math team coach Sheena Kewley said the hour long math contest, written Feb. 19, was a thinking type contest in which "students must have a really good analytical brain as well as good math skills."

GDHS Grade 9s finished 18th in Ontario and second in Halton-Peel and Halton standings, giving them both Canadian and Ontario Honor Roll status.

Lord Elgin High

School in Burlington took top place in the Halton and Halton-Peel standings.

Lynn Schenk and Lisa Thurston, who were not available for a picture, were placed on the Halton-Peel Honor Roll for finishing in the top one per cent in the district.

Grade 10 student at GDHS Eric Shynal placed first in the Cayley Math Contest, third in Halton-Peel, 52nd in Ontario and was in the top one per cent in Canada placing him on the Canadian Honor Roll.

As a team the GDHS Grade 10s scored 302 out of a possible 450 points placing them fourth in Halton, seventh in

Halton-Peel and tied for 46th in Ontario.

The school team consisted of Grade 10 students Eric Shynal, Rona Yardley and Martin Barnard.

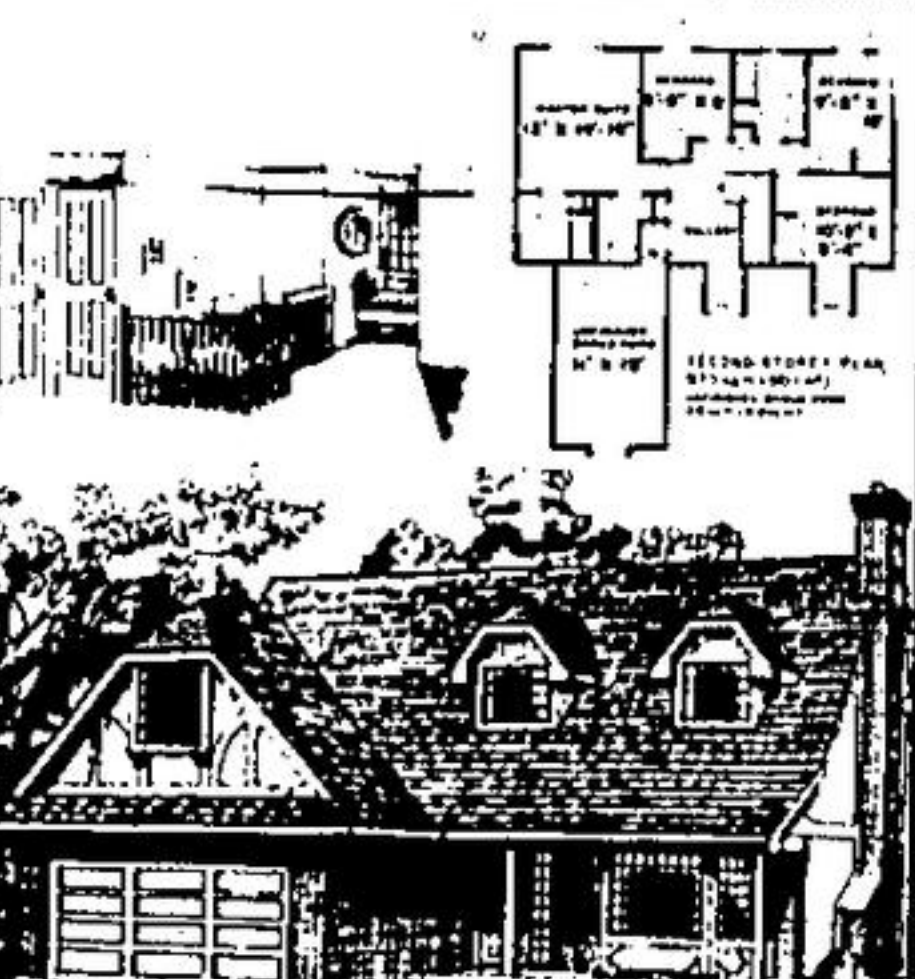
