## She proves cancer can be beaten

Patricia McKinnon, guest speaker at the Halton Hills Cancer Society's appreciation night is living proof that cancer can be beaten.

The appreciation night Monday night at the John Elliott Theatre was an attempt by the Society to reach the canvassers, the ones who aren't thanked enough, said Halton Hills Unit president, Barbara Johnson. "They are the grass-roots," she said.

One hundred and fifteen attended the evening which featured a film about Miss McKinnon's battle against cancer, a talk by Miss McKinnon, a question and answer period and a social hour with wine and cheese.

Miss McKinnon, a

singer who has a record out, was first diagnosed as having Hodgkins Disease in 1973. She underwent radiation therapy and chemotherapy.

The same disease reappeared in 1980, but in a different part of her body. Miss McKinnon again underwent radiation therapy and chemotherapy.

Miss McKinnon is a survivor who has been clear of the disease since 1980. Mrs. Johnson said the society wanted to inspire the canvassers with someone who had survived cancer. She stated that in many of the films out about cancer the patient had eventually died.
