
## Places to visit

gives you a guide on what's available in the area.



Crawford Lake Conservation Area is quickly growing into a scenic hot spot and a great place to bring the kids so they might learn about Indian folklore.








At Milton's Kelso Conservation Area it's possible to swim or rent a canoe, sailboat or windsurfer. For more information call 878-5011.




