What makes it so special? Reaction from the visual artists: Great! A real challenge! I don't like juried shows! The ones selected depend on the personal taste of the judge. Glad to see there is an opportunity for Halton Hills to display its best 'colors'.

In response to the public reaction, a juried snow means that the works displayed are considered to be of the very best quality of those submitted. They are selected by a panel of professional artists who through their own high quality work have earned the privilege of judging others' creations.

Here and Now '85 is such a show. The jury will be made up of three professionals who live outside of the area. The judges are Joyce Aster, a fabric artist who has gained notoriety for her hangings created in felt that she has made herself; Rudolf Bikkers, a master printer and painter who runs his own print shop Additions Canada in London and is head of the print department at the Ontario College of Art; and Heather Grindley, a graphic artist and painter whose work is done in a variety of media.

The title Here and Now '85 means that this show is a record of the high standard of work in paintings, wallhangings, drawings, mixed media and original prints completed this year in the area of Halton Hills.




