

Mountainview man disagrees over status

The status of an application to amend the Georgetown Secondary Plans came into question Monday when applicant Peter Woolgar came to council wanting to know where it stood.

Road South contained in the Secondary Plans, also asked council to waive the \$400 application fee which he was requested to pay when he submitted his letter of intent.

Mr. Woolgar said he felt residents should not have to pay such high fees to get a hearing on a matter of concern involving their own neighborhood.

"A woman came down and said she'd seen a man fall past her window," building superintendent Lou Egerton said.

"We found him on the second floor extension over the front entrance."

Unemployed, Mr. Richardson was a resident at the Village Manor Rest Home in Acton. He was visiting his widowed mother in her ninth floor home at 62 Park Ave. in Georgetown before he jumped.

"He has been under medical treatment for the past six years," Staff Sgt. Roy Smith said. "He had been taking medication, and may not have taken it that day."

The Staff Sergeant said the young man's mother had heard her son talking on the phone just prior to the accident. When she went to look for him, she couldn't find him.

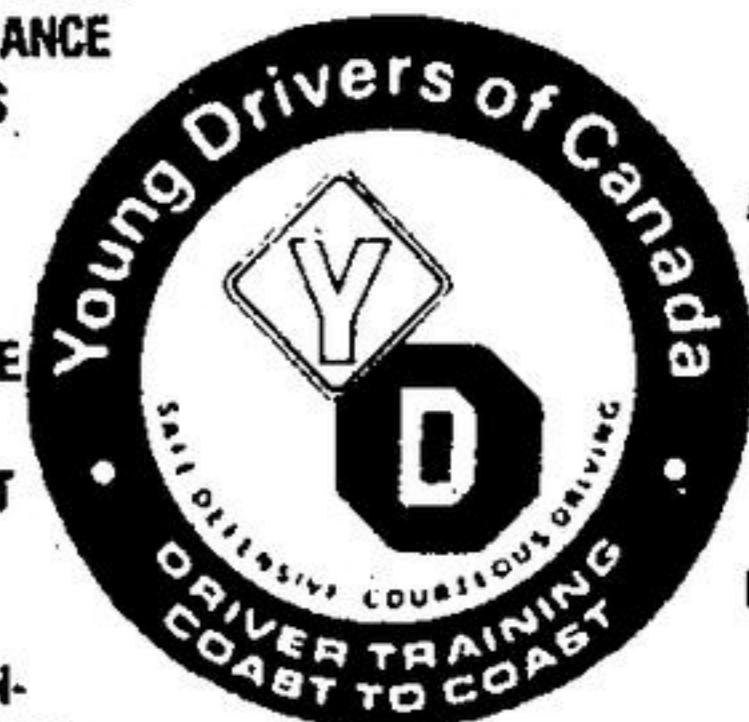

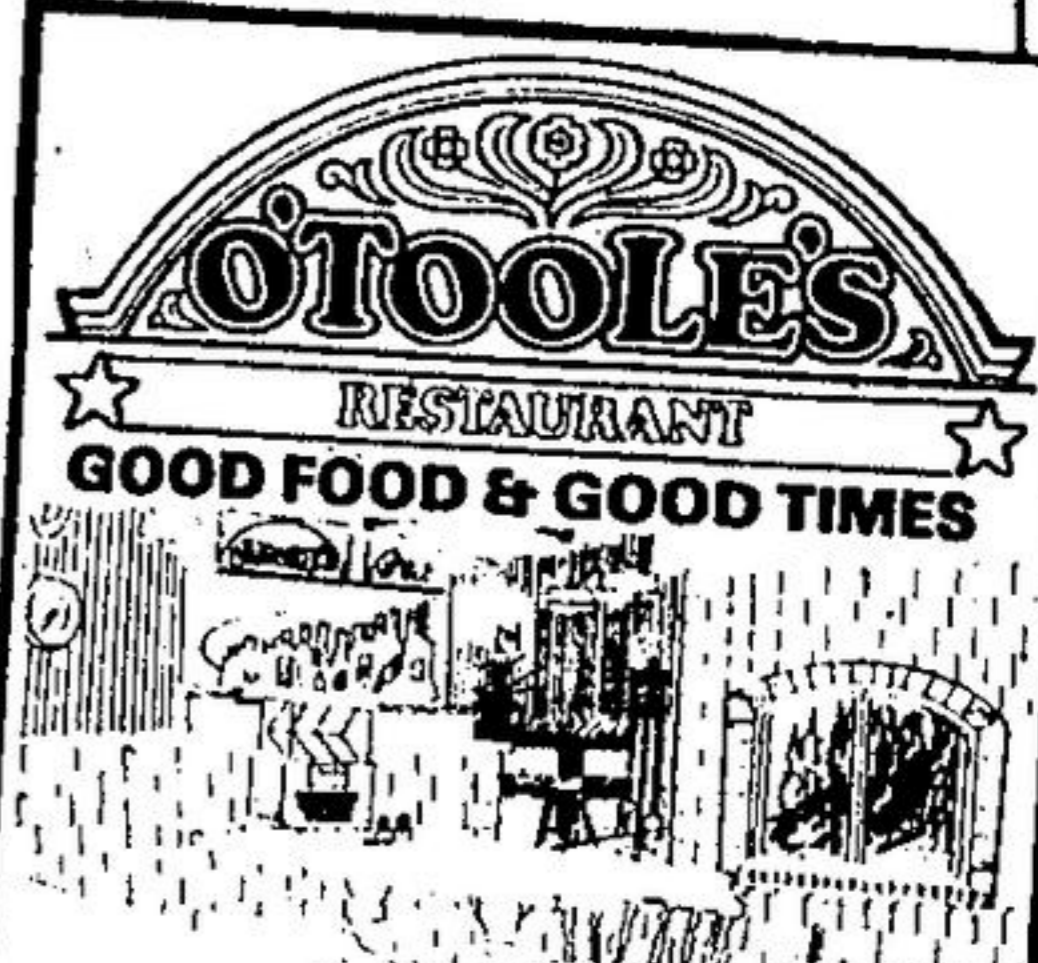
