

Mandy is waiting to be discovered

Imagine if you were a singer songwriter discovered by the man putting aluminum siding on your house. That is the story of 15-year-old Georgetown District High School student Mandy Inglis.

Two years ago Matt Hajer heard Mandy while he was working on her home and encouraged her. Since then, he has become a regular visitor at the Inglis home and the one who takes Mandy to talent contests for country and western entertainers around southern Ontario.

"She's got talent. It's a matter of struggling along before something clicks," Mr. Hajer said.

He is hoping something will click in London Sept. 7, 8, and 9 at a Southwestern Ontario contest for would-be country stars sponsored by CKGL 96.7 FM.

The London competition is a play-off with the semi-finals Sept. 12 and 13, and finals Sept. 15. Mandy qualified for the event by being one of the top three in a Kitchener competition Aug. 27.

These competitions are for young talents

between 13 and 22 years old. Their goal, to win the finals in London, if realized, will advance them to a dream competition in Memphis, Tennessee. The prize there is \$500 and an audition with CBS records.

If it wasn't for Matt Hajer, Mandy wouldn't be striving for Memphis. Her interest in music started when she was nine.

"We had to make a musical instrument. I made mine from a ruler, a shoe box, elastic bands and I wrote a song. My father heard it and the next day he bought me a guitar," Mandy said.

Mandy is a self-taught guitar player. She could play the banjo and piano the first time she tried, she said. Mandy spends so much time with her music that it contributes to some so-so grades at school.

"I failed music twice. I think it's because music at school is band music and no words. I hate that," she said.

Mandy met Burton Cummings recently. He advised her to first get an education and then work on her music. "Those are her new priorities," she said.

Stompin' Tom Con

nors' step-brother Wayne Chapman stayed at the Inglis home for four or five months. He plays lead guitar professionally and practiced lead to Mandy's songs.

"He told me I was going to make it and not to give up. He was an inspiration as well because he was always supporting me," she said.

Last Christmas Mandy met Stompin' Tom at his Christmas party. He told her to "keep on with my music and not to give up and to keep writing my own songs," she said.

Mandy has written about 20 songs in the last two years. She has pared down the 20 to eight.

"I like to keep songs people will clap their hands to. I like happy songs that people can dance to," she said.

Mandy is serious about her music. When most of her friends are listening to rock and roll she is playing country.

"I like it (country music) because more people can relate to it. I mostly relate to older people with country music," she said.

Having her own band is one of Mandy's goals. "I want someone serious and really into country," she said. When she has those ingredients, she plans to make a demo and try to market it.

Singing for a large audience inspires Mandy. It's the small ones that make her nervous.

"The bigger the audience the better I do. I'd give my eye teeth to perform every day," she said.

She concedes there are people better than her in the competition but emphasizes her good attitude will help.

"I'm good. I'll make it there (to Memphis). I'll never quit, she said. If she doesn't make it this year perhaps next year will be Mandy's year.

Council heard no submissions or even questions from the public during a public meeting Monday to amend the town's official plan for properties at the corner of Guelph Street and Delrex Boulevard.

Knolcrest Properties Ltd., owner corner properties, wanted the permitted uses in the highway commercial designation of the official plan expanded to include limited offices for the site and also to increase the amount of leasable floor area to 21,000 square feet from 17,500.

The amendment was required, deputy planner Bruce MacLean said, to bring the lands into conformity with the town's new Official Plan and to incorporate the two changes.

Council will receive staff comments and make a decision at a later date.

Building permits up 51 per cent in Halton

The Halton Business Development Department has announced that building permits in the region for the first six months of 1985 have already exceeded the yearly total for 1984.

It should be noted that 1984 was the best year in the past 10 years for building permit values.

At the mid-year point, building permits across the region for industrial and commercial permits are up 51 per cent, \$27,706,005 for the same time period in 1984.

Building permit totals for residential, industrial, commercial, institutional, agricultural and miscellaneous for January - June '85 are up 68 per cent (\$141,624,810) over the same period of time in 1984.

The building permit value activity indicates that companies have finalized major expansion or relocation plans, a reflection of strong economic growth being experienced in Halton region.

The Business Development Department believes that the economic activity will continue to grow for the remainder of the year.

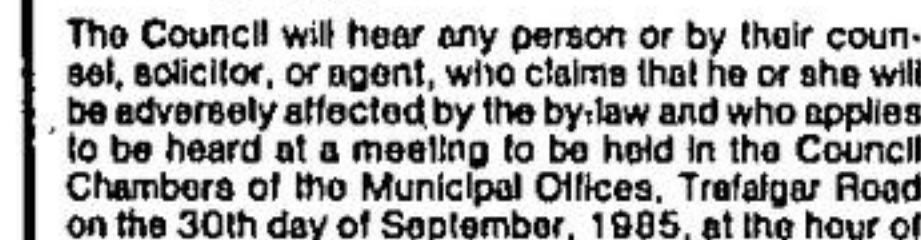
