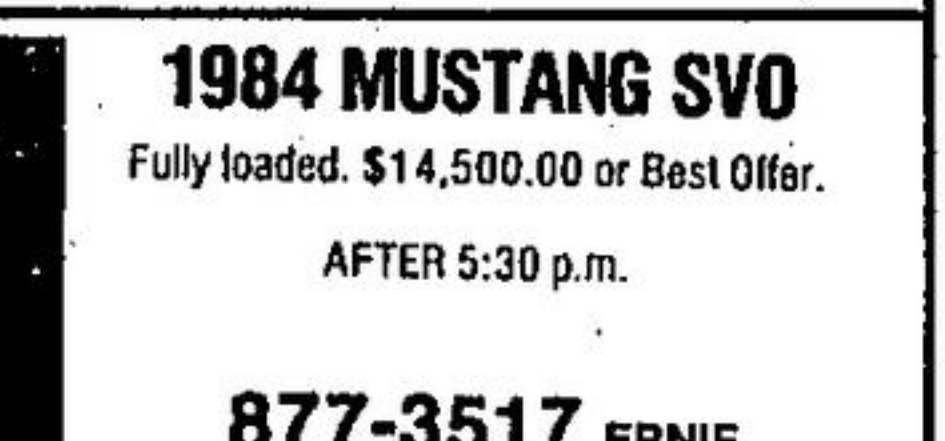

Mr. Nurse also won the championship for junior females in the class with his entry, Hanover Hill Bambi.

The grand championship for females went to Elmlawn Farms of RR4 Georgetown.

The Elmlawn entry, Elmlawn Cher, was also the top five-year-old female.

Gord Gustard, another RR4 Georgetown resident, had the best bull calf, Canadiana Prestar Prophet and the top female calf, Stuknoll Designer Patricia.

In the junior Holstein show, 14-year-old Marimo Kubota of RR2 Georgetown won the showmanship contest for her skill in the show ring.

Also in the junior exhibitors' class, Ronald Bird of RR2 Georgetown, won second place in the heifer championship with his entry, Birdom Becky. Jim Bursey of RR4 Georgetown, showed the best junior heifer.

Anne and her 'Zero' leaping for medals

Horse lovers are well known for the odd names they give their animals, but 14-year-old Anne Auty's horse, "Saved By Zero" has drawn its share of comments.

"When he was just a baby he got caught in a wire fence and cut his knee. Doctors said there wasn't much they could do, but he healed on his own," said the Grade 10 Acton High School student about her five-year-old grown gelding.

Anne was one of about 50 competitors who participated last weekend in the Canadian National Exhibition's hunter and jumper show. The show marked the end of the fair's 19 days of horse competitions.

As one of the youngest competitors among the 10-12 horse owners who brought their animals down to the fair from Gim Crack Farms in Kettleby, Anne showed her mettle and her horsemanship skills by winning ribbons in three competitions riding against some of the best junior competitors in the province.

Anne and Saved By Zero came third in the green working hunter under saddle class and also in the first year green working hunter.

The winning pair also walked away with a fourth place ribbon in the green working hunter stake.

Prior to the CNE horse show Anne and her horse came first in the junior exhibition and third in the junior working hunter competitions in the Ontario zone.

Anne began competing at the CNE and is the only member of her family and among her friends to actively participate in equestrian competitions.

"They think it's great. A lot of them look up to me and say it's great. A lot of them say I'm a snob." Even as a novice horse owner and competitor, Anne says she is used to misconceptions that horse owners are somehow "not normal because they're riders."
