shipping data. Regional planner Rash Mohammed estimates that because of increased construction in Peel

region in recent years and a decline in construction in Metro Toronto, a higher proportion of the exported aggregate is now going to Peel than did in 1977.

In 1977, about 33 per cent of the exported sand and gravel was shipped to Metro Toronto

and 29 per cent to Peel region. The average annual revenue from the export of aggregates from 1980 to 1983 is about \$20 million for Halton, Mr. Mohammed reports.






