

## ANGELS WE HAVE HEARD ON HIGH

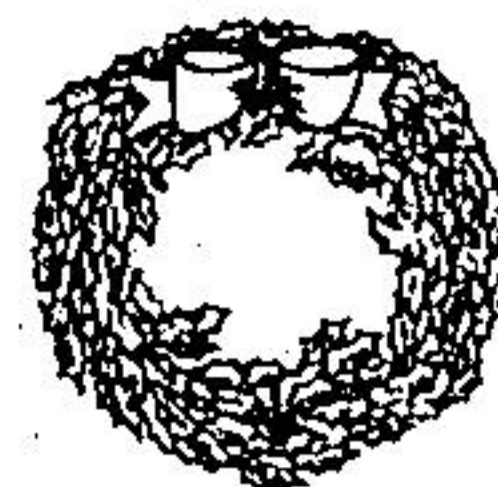
