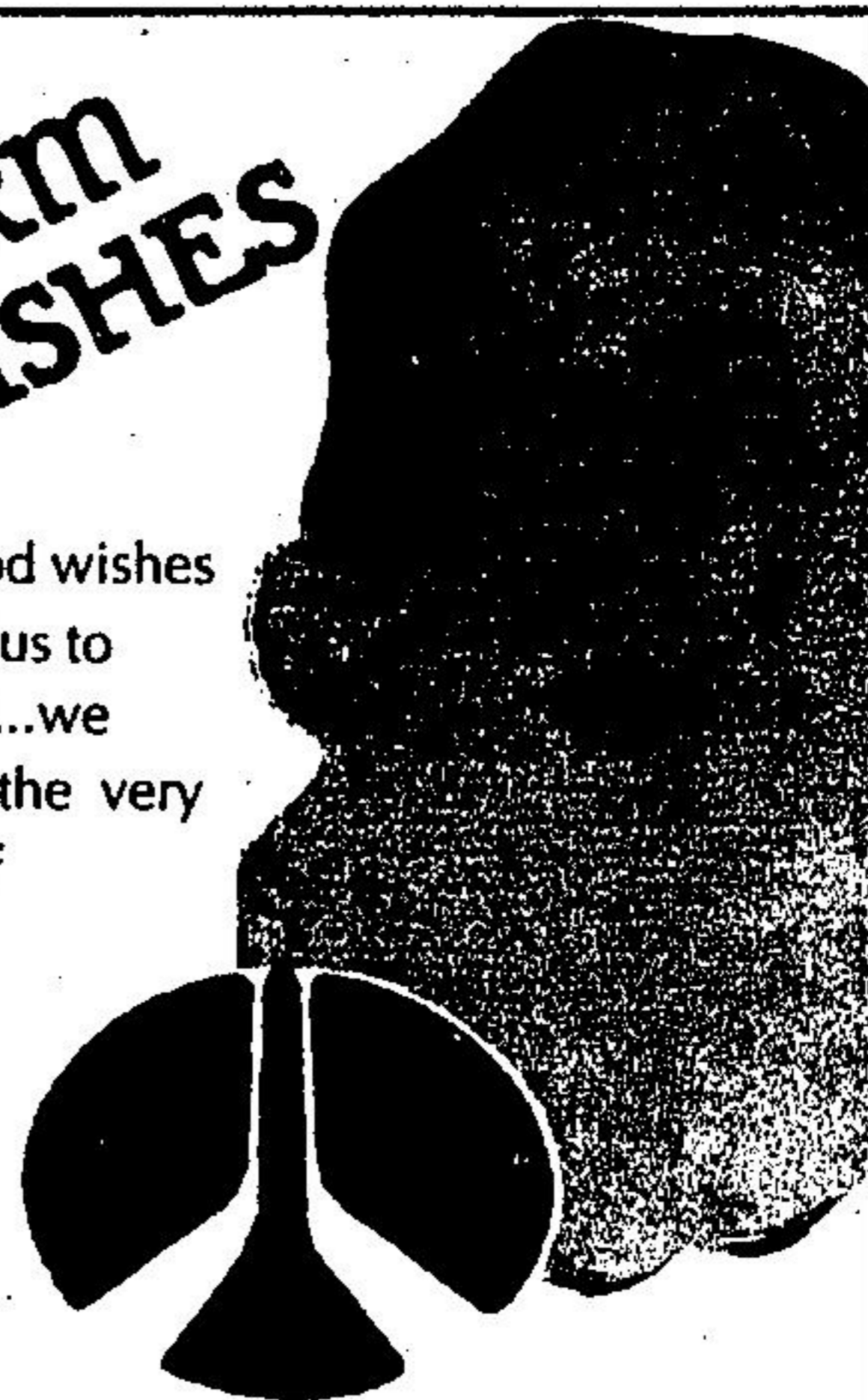
On the tenth day of Christmas my true love gave to me
