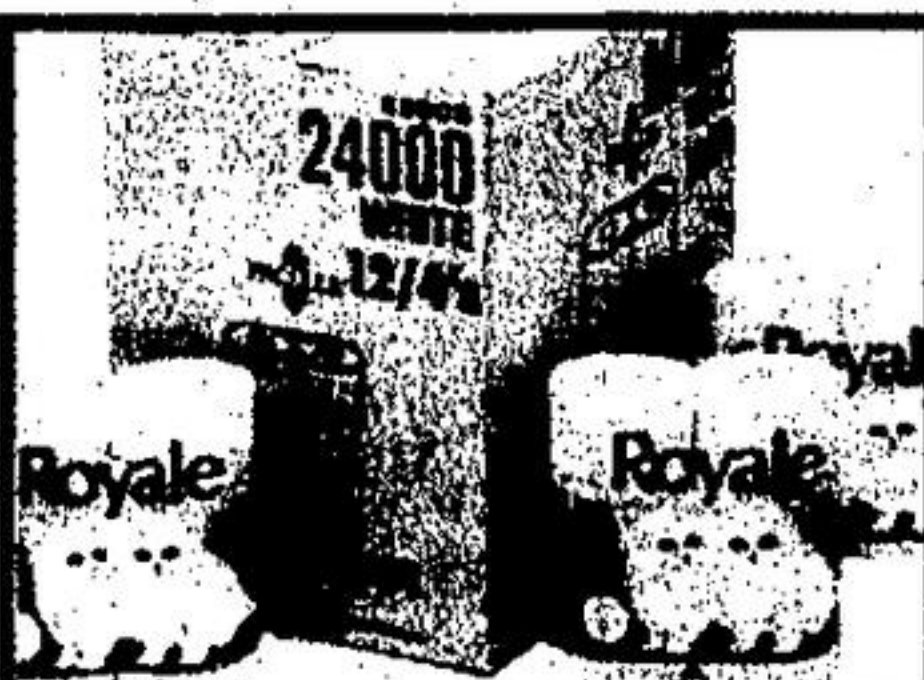
John's father Clarence Lyons, at 90 years, still maintains a keen interest as well.

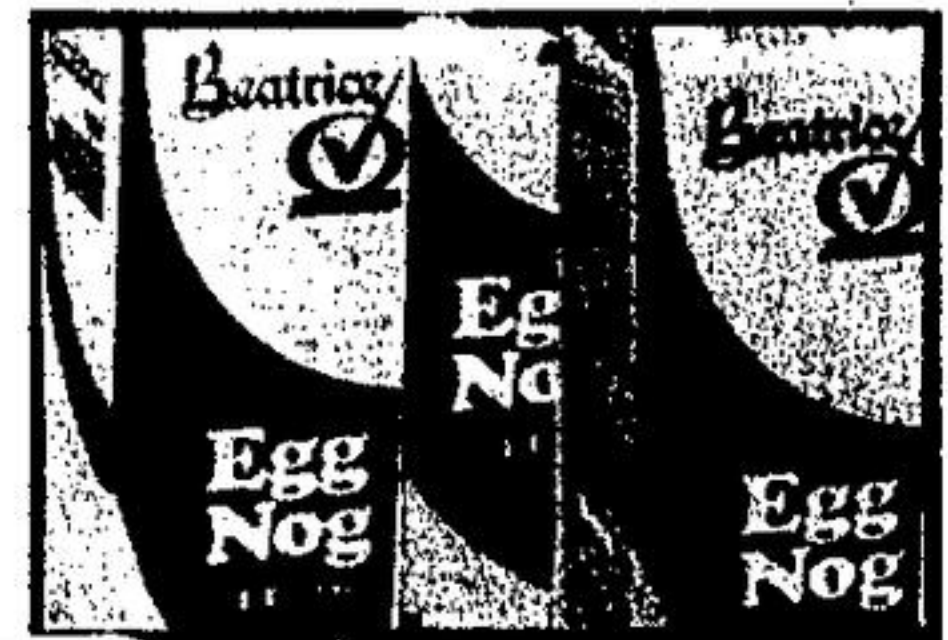
