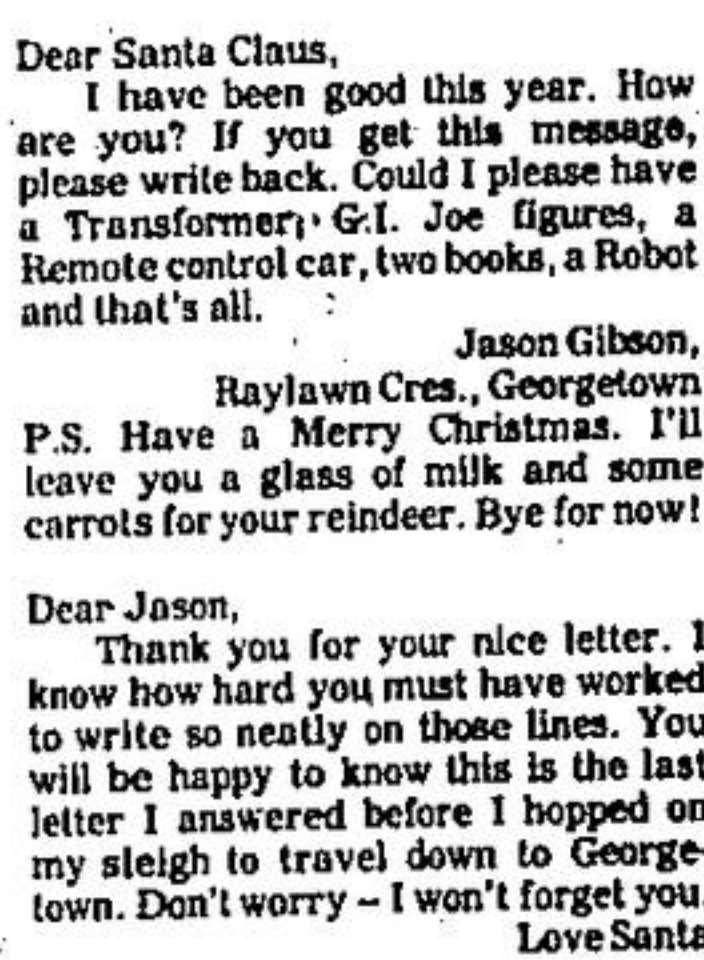
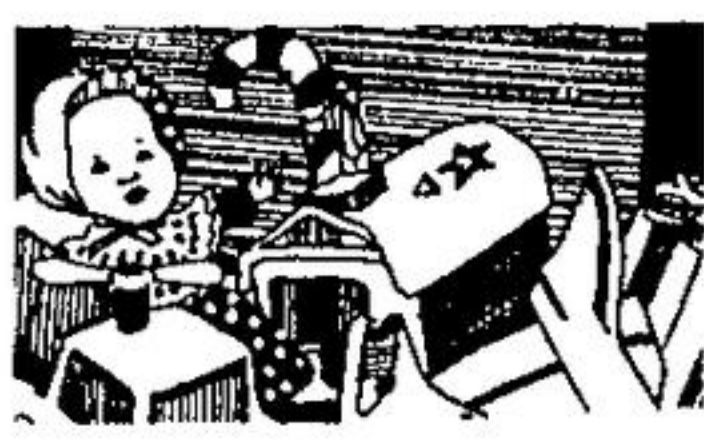

Winter at Mountsberg

Experience winter and nature at the Mountsberg Wildlife Centre during the 'Winter Experience' program, starting Boxing Day to January 5 and then every weekend until February 23.

Horse drawn sleigh or wagon rides take you through snow covered forests while cross country skiers explore the 13.7 km of trails. With cross country ski, snowshoe and toboggan rentals, visitors can choose from a variety of activities. There is also a pond for skating and bonfires to keep the chill away.

Birds of prey, live elk and bison on the Wildlife Walkway provide visitors with a view of nature in winter. Don't miss the farm animals in the historic Cameron Barn.

Regular presentations pertaining to winter are shown in the Interpretive Centre and guides are available for hikes or trail information.

Two special events are planned during the Winter Experience program - Owl Prowl on January 24 and a Valentine Moonlight Ski on February 14, both events are carried out from 6:30 p.m. to 9 p.m. The Owl Prowl includes 'hooting lessons' designed to attract owls in the wild. There is also an informative presentation on owls, a puppet show, and a guided night hike to call for owls. Bring your sweetheart for a guided cross country ski hike in the moonlight on Valentine's Day. Horse-drawn sleigh rides and night skating are also offered.
