Separation is the most likely reason for grounds for divorce in Ontario, Statistics Canada says. Adultery is the second most commonly cited reason, according to 1983 figures.

NO KIDS
About half the divorces granted in Ontario in 1983 did not involve dependent children, Statistics Canada says.

BOOZE
An addiction to alcohol was cited in 131 cases as a reason for marriage breakdown in Ontario, according to divorce statistics from Statistics Canada. There were 23,073 divorces granted in Ontario that year.

Images of 1985 -- the year in review

There were a number of newsworthy events in Halton Hills during 1985. Here's a sampling of some of the major stories that made headlines last year.

NEW IN TOWN:
Our New Year's Baby was Lyndsey Hole. The Bennett Health Care Centre opened for the public. A Georgetown Chapter of the Kidney Foundation received their charter. After much study and with a variety of donations, a Youth Employment Centre opens in Acton and Georgetown, run by the YMCA. Kids on the Block comes to Halton Hills. The puppet show tells children about the disabled.

Wintario comes to Georgetown and over 226,000 prizes were given out. Halley's Comet is overhead, but few can see the comet because of cloudy skies. 911 emergency telephone number comes to Halton.

SOMETHING TO CELEBRATE
An Official Plan is approved by Dennis Timbrell, allowing the town to grow. Morely Servos and his friend Stan Wilkin fly for the first time their re-built 1938 Beachcraft D175 Staggerwing. Dave Ashbee raises \$600 for Ethiopia's famine victims by running in a 10 km race. The Anglers and Hunters Association hold a successful sportsman's show at Gordon Alcott arena. Rock and Roll star Robbie Lane comes to town to entertain for a charity dance to help tornado victims. Town members participate in Halton Hills day at the CNE Aug. 15. A car derby is a hit at the Georgetown Fall Fair.

PAIN AND BOWROW:
Two die in a Christmas Day blaze, but Marorie McKerr survives. Car dealer and popular citizen Andrew Murray dies as a result of a heart attack. A blizzard topples the roof at Alumina Products, injuring seven employees.

Town taxes will rise by 6.8 per cent with garbage rates a major factor in the increase. A community writer for The Herald for 20 years, Mrs. Lillian Bellbody passes away. A local man, Martin Ebling, is thrown from a ferris wheel cab along with his five year old son.

A tornado lashes out at residents in Grand Valley, Orangeville and Barrie, but locals in Halton Hills help out. Indira Kaur Kalist is killed when her Air India jetliner crashes en route to India. She was 21.

AWARDS TIME:
Steam Emmerson is the Lion's Club Citizen of the Year for Georgetown. In business, Barry Whitworth wins the Business of the Year award, presented by the Chamber of Commerce. The Herald wins two awards at the Ontario Community Newspaper Association - sponsored contest. Steve Frost accepts the Photoart top prize at a ceremony held at the cultural centre. Bob Goldham is the hockey heritage recipient.

Former Red Cross president Henry Kroes is named the Acton Citizen of the Year. Frank Black, an area artist, is chosen as The Herald's Pioneer Citizen of '85.

A POLITICAL YEAR:
Three of 10 Halton-Burlington delegates want Frank Miller as their provincial leader. They get their wish. Julian Reed resigns as the MPP for Halton-Burlington. Later, Liberal candidate Don Knight is acclaimed as his successor. Mr. Knight defeats PC candidate Peter Pomeroy by a very narrow margin of votes in the May provincial election.

Councillors were unanimous in approving two Secondary Plans that will allow Georgetown to grow. Eleven delegations spoke to council members, 9 criticizing the plans or asking for amendments. Town council approves one less school board trustee for Halton Hills.

Mike Armstrong announces that he will challenge incumbent Mayor Russ Miller for his position. Mayor Miller retains his seat with nearly a 2-1 margin over Mr. Armstrong. Peter Pomeroy wins back his post at regional chairman. Arlene Bruce beats out a Halton school board veteran to become Chairman of the Halton Board of Education.

NAMES IN THE NEWS:
Alex Furness questions town councillors about land known as the Steven's property. A couple participate in a marathon dance to help crippled children. Their names are: Bob and Carol Marchand and Ron and Dayle Orton. Rev. Jim Boyles returns from Russia after a two week tour of churches there. Former Lady of the Fair, Emily Bessey, dies in her Kincourt home.
