Trustees divided on 6% tax hike

Not all school trustees seem destined to support a budget that could raise taxes by 6 per cent. Depending on Ontario grants, an increase per household could range from \$75 per year to \$97 for a home assessed at \$7,000.

Some Halton Board of Education trustees feel a 6 per cent increase is too much for taxpayers to handle and they won't accept the budget in its present form.

Taxi fare increase

Taxi fares are on their way up. Councillors approved a fare increase to \$1.50 for the first one-sixth of a kilometer and 20 cents for each additional one-sixth of a kilometer at Monday night's general committee meeting.

Under current rates, it costs \$1.90 to take a cab one kilometer. With the increase, it will cost \$2.50 to travel the same distance.
