

At Smith and O'Flaherty:

Shredded coconuts for donuts processed by staff of 38

Smith and O'Flaherty is a manufacturer and marketer of supplies and ingredients to several segments of the food industry within Canada. These segments include the dairy, bakery and confectionary industries. The company relocated its principal approximately 2 years ago, from Montreal. This move was necessitated by an increase in the company's business activity in Ontario and Western Canada, and the need to better service these customers.

The company was formed in 1934 in Montreal as a manufacturer representative of bakery and confectionary supplies. From there, Smith and O'Flaherty became a flavour supplier to the ice cream industry, and developed a market for frozen novelties. The next addition was supplying Canadian dairies with ice cream sandwich supplies, and that marked the beginning of major expansion.

The plant in Georgetown is involved in processing various types of nuts which includes peanuts and coconuts. The products are tailored to customer needs, and include things such as shredded coconut that tops many of the donuts and cookies you eat. The peanuts are used in many different products that include many of Canada's favorite chocolate bars. Also manufactured are flavours that are used in ice cream and fruit beverages. Smith and O'Flaherty Inc. has also developed a wide range of stabilizers for many of today's food products. All of this manufacturing comes under the scrutiny of a Quality Control Department, which ensures that all products are of first quality.

Smith and O'Flaherty Inc. is a

marketer of many consumer goods within the ice cream industry. These products include such well known products as Ice Cream Sandwiches, and Snack and 1/2 Sandwiches. Smith and O'Flaherty Inc. develops the packaging and supplies all ingredients, except for the ice cream, to Canada's dairy industry, who, in turn, produce the finished products either under their own name or Smith and O'Flaherty Inc. trade name of Peter Penguin. In addition to the products themselves, Smith

and O'Flaherty Inc. has the capability to design and engineer the machinery required to manufacture these products.

The first 50 years have been good to the company, and the next 50 hold promises of more expansion and diversification. A commitment to research and development will ensure new products to better serve the Canadian food industry, and the Canadian consumer. The company is actively engaged in developing export markets for its products, and

will continue to strengthen the overall operation.

When the company moved to Georgetown, the majority of the

employees were hired from the local area. Smith and O'Flaherty Inc. now employ 38 people in Georgetown and endeavour to hire new staff from the

local area. All the employees share a sense of pride in the quality of their products, and the effective manner in which Smith and O'Flaherty Inc. conducts its business.

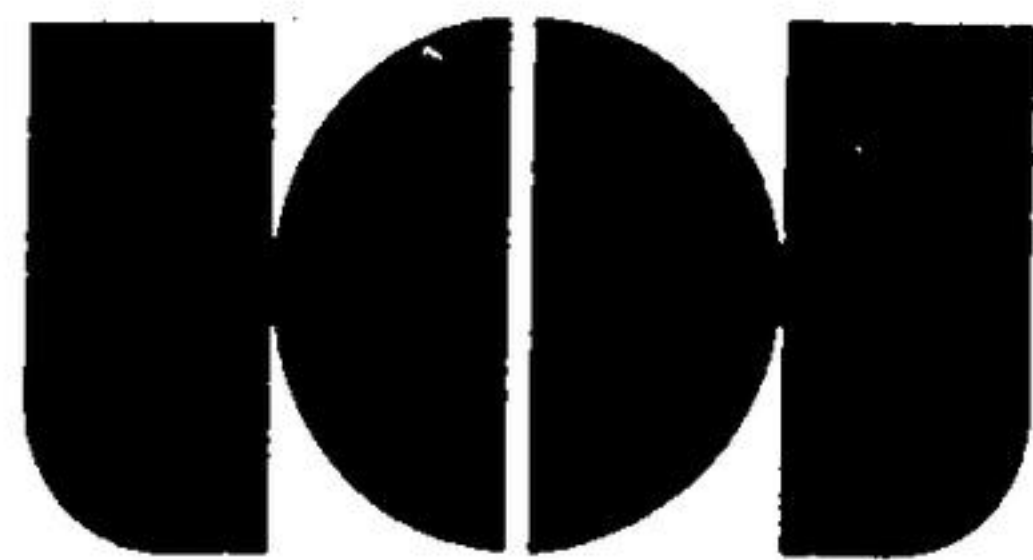
The glass can come in different tints of bronze or even a reflective glass. Pool enclosures is also a popular
