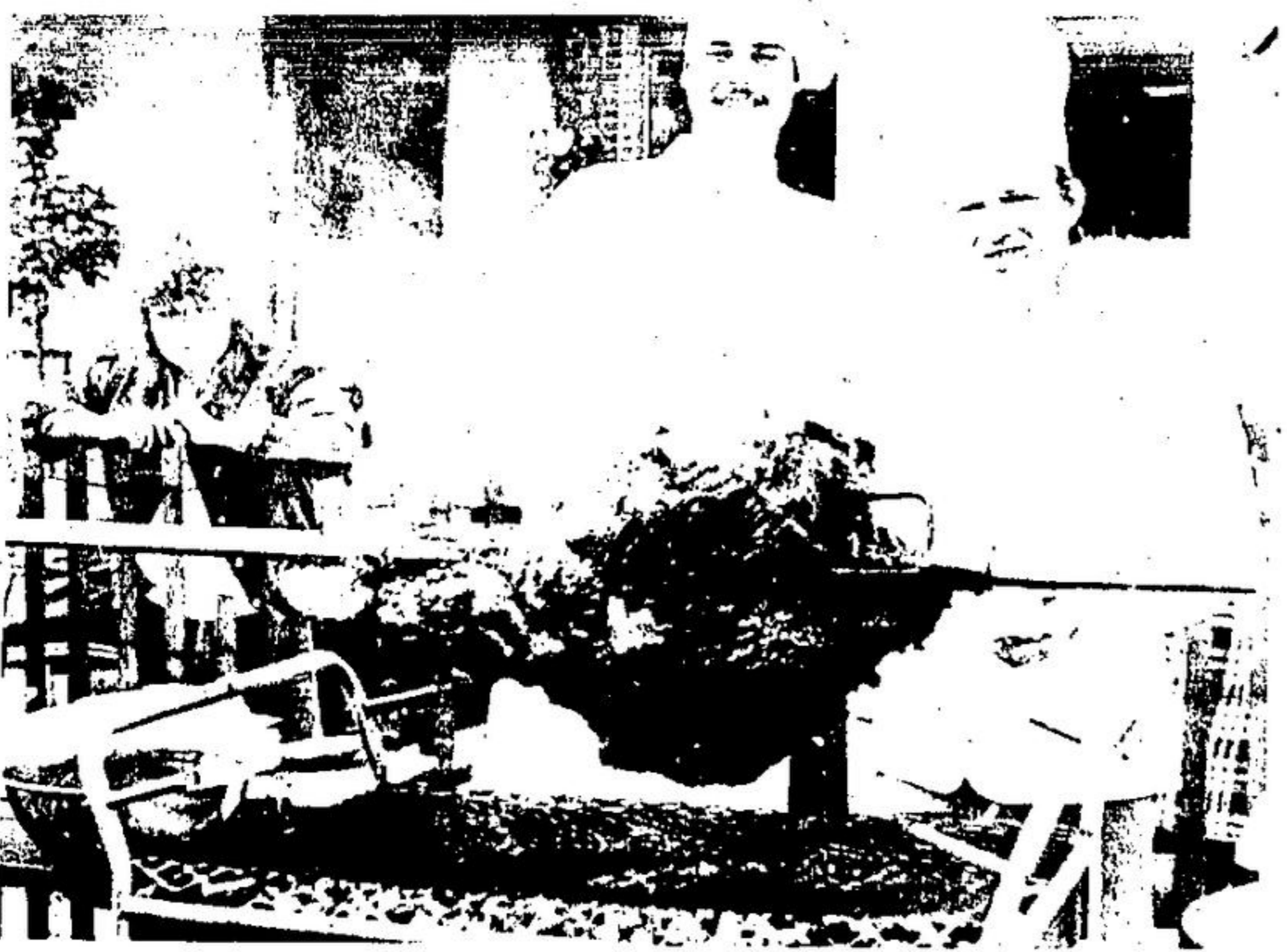

There may be shopping bargains for the adults, but children seem to have the most fun at Pioneer Days. During the three day event there was a costume contest, bike

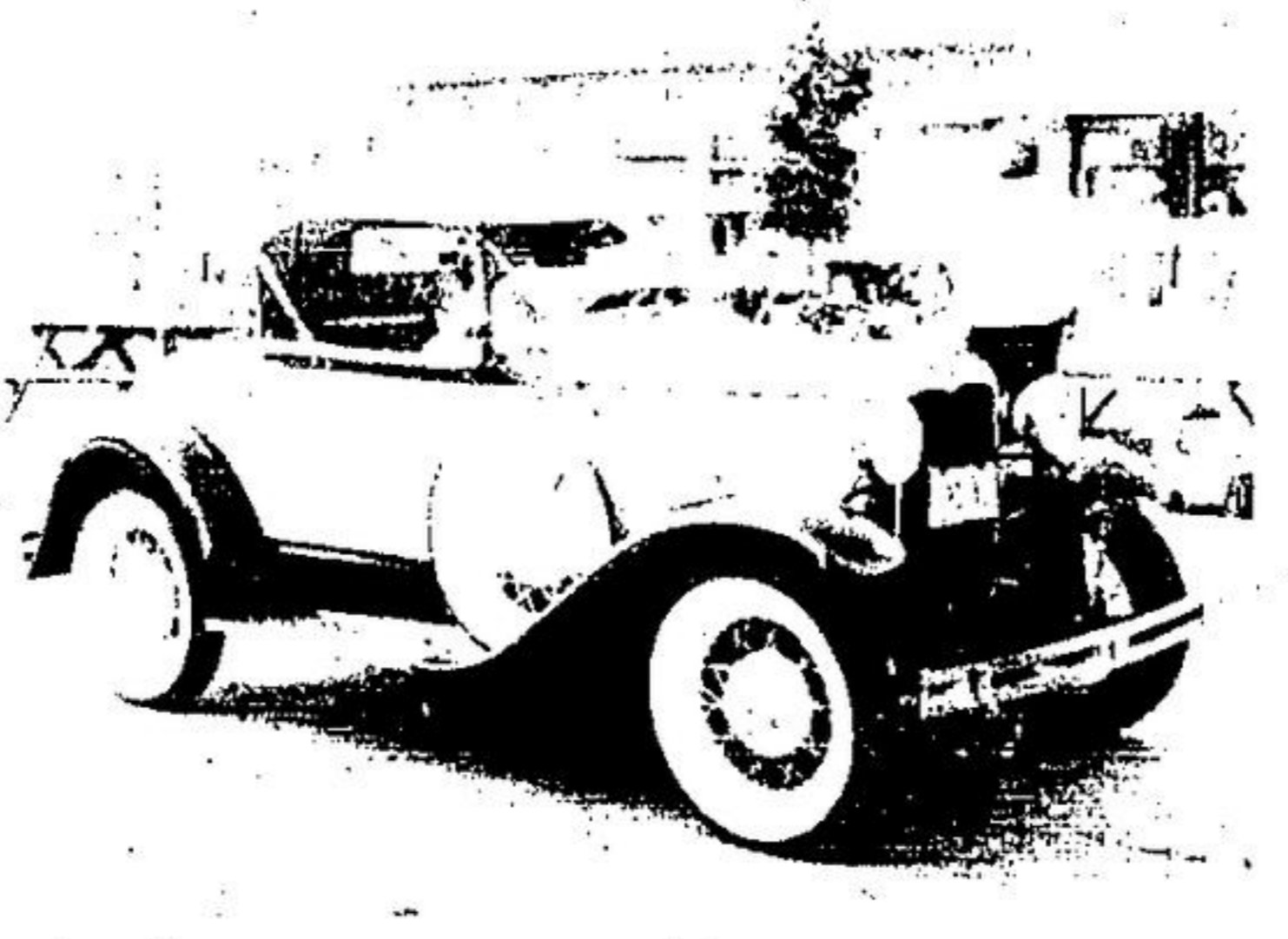
parades, free balloons and much more for the smaller ones. Even the street musicians found an appreciative audience among the youngsters.



Merchants went all out for Pioneer Days, reducing the prices on their stock and putting attractive merchandise out on the sidewalk. Many of the retail stores had employees

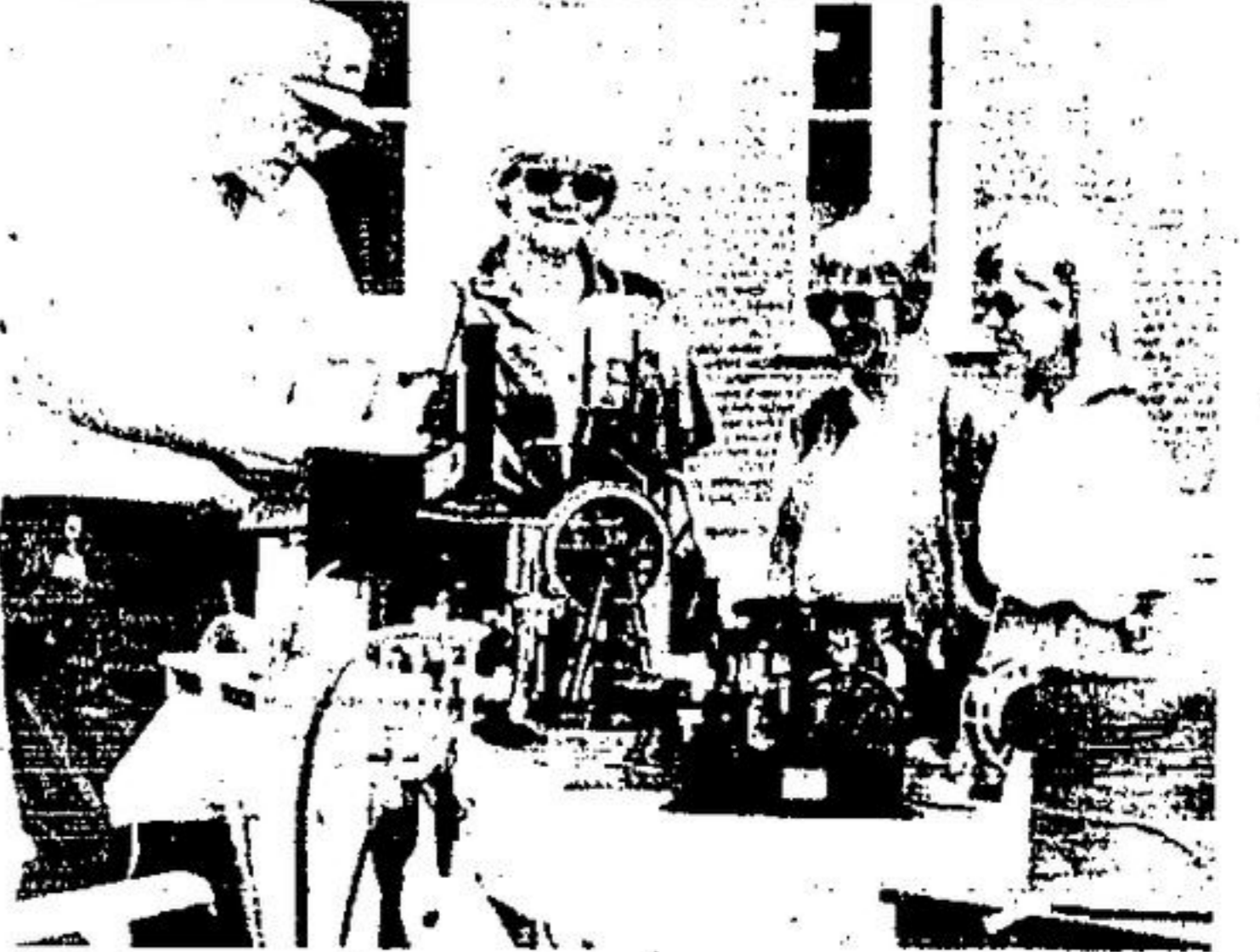
who dressed in pioneer garb. There were quite a few authentic cowboys and saloon girls dressing up for the day. Top marks have to go to the employees at Canada Trust.
