 The program begins at 7:30 p.m. July 31. Materials will be provided. For more information call 451-1615.

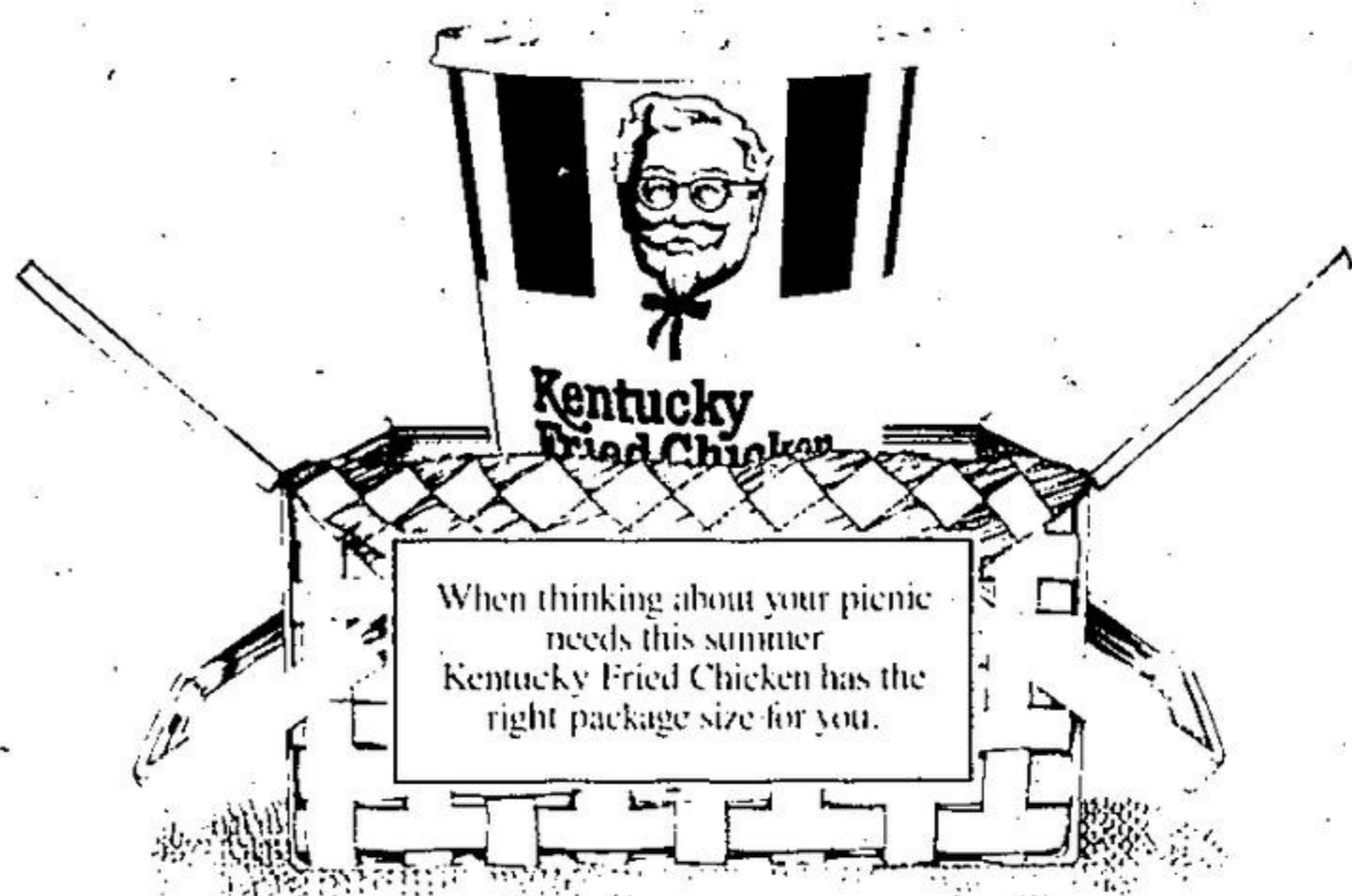
### Monthly ads
