Most common configuration

The most common patio door has one stationary panel and one operating panel. The operating panel can either slide or swing open and shut.

Well-made patio doors have a wood frame because wood is a natural insulator, says the National Wood Window & Door Association.

Two other requirements of a wellmade patio door are factory-applied weatherstripping and double glazing. Weatherstripping prevents energy loss around the frame, while double glazing reduces heat loss through the glass area.

Wood patio doors are available at local lumber yards, home centers and building supply stores. They come in six, eight, nine and 12-foot widths. Many have a protective exterior cladding that virtually eliminates the need for painting.


