Tasty Recipes

WACKY CAKE

Sift together into an 8"x8" pan (ungreased):

- 1 1/2 c. all-purpose flour
- 1 c. sugar
- 1 tsp. baking powder
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 4 tbsp. cocoa

Level off in pan and make 3 holes with a spoon. In first hole put 1 tsp. vanilla. In second hole put 1 tsp. vinegar. In third hole put 5 tbsp. melted butter. Pour over this 1 cup of warm water. Mix all ingredients together until the flour has disappeared. Bake 30 minutes at 350 degrees.
