We were served for Sunday brunch, helping ourselves to as much as our eyes and stomachs could savor. For a total bill of \$25 for two, we feasted on a tasty meal, which began with the salad bar. Next in line were the cold cuts and a variety of items such as smoked salmon, herring,

chicken, eggs and tomatoes suitably stuffed with yummy fillings.

The hot buffet was served by a helpful chef. We had the choice of a wonderful selection of roast beef, beef stew, breaded pork with plum sauce, pancakes, bacon and sausages. For the more adventurous they had a dish of alligator and kippers. A full complement of rolls and croissants were available, also.

The nicest surprise came at the dessert table where the fresh cheese cake caught our eye. There was yogurt and fruit salad for the weight-watchers. For

those still hungry there were tarts, two types of pies, Black Forest cake and puddings.

The restaurant has a relaxed atmosphere about it. The tables are not too close, the hanging plants, stone walls, wood beams and large windows all add to a feeling of comfort.

The dinner menu at Hickory's also looked very inviting. There's a good selection of seafood, veal, chicken and steaks. For those watching their weight, the chefs have also prepared a menu of lighter entrees.
