# No place for garbage if gov't won't renew

Your garbage may be left with nowhere to go June end, if a letter from the Ministry of the Environ-

ment is upheld. Leferink Disposals Limited and Halton Region have received a letter from the Ministry saying it plans to revoke the licence to operate a temporary transfer station in Halton Hills June 30.

"It puts us in one heck of a position if we're not to have a temporary transfer station." Coun. Pam Sheldon said at Monday night's general committee meeting.

Because the town is more than 45 minutes drive from the Regional landfill, it has been allowed to collect municipal wastes at a site on Armstrong Avenue, compact it, then make the drive down to the sole Halton dump. The Ministry apparently is now saying no to continuation of this practice.

Coun. Sheldon sald the Region's chief administrative office, has been given verbal assurance that the Ministry will renew the temporary transfer station permit, despite the

Councillors passed a motion giving support "in principle" to the Leferink application for a permanent transfer station in Halton Hills. The motion asks the Ministry to deem that a hearing under the Environmental Protection Act isn't




