Welfare change late

The province has lousy timing when it makes changes that affect regional wallets.

That's the message the Region's director of social services wants to pass on to the Minister of Community and Social Services, John Sweeney.

Thanks to two changes in the mandatory General Welfare Assistance, announced after the Region's 1986 budget had been set, the Region is over budget by \$10,300 in its welfare

program. What the province did, was increase the shelter subsidy to welfare recipients, and introduce a winter clothing allowance for them. This was done in September, long after the Region set its budget for welfare payments for 1986.

A resolution from the County of Lennox and Addington chides the Ministry for its poor timing, and its adoption of new game rules without consulting local municipalities.
