

Big band sounds at Casa Loma

Casa Loma announced today that its Big Band Dance series, introduced in 1966, will continue in 1987 with the Tom de Moraes Swing Orchestra. The Spring Series dance will be held on two Saturday evenings: February 28th and April 25th.

The Tom de Moraes Orchestra, a sixteen piece band, plays the music of Big Band era greats, including hits by Benny Goodman, Les Brown, Gene Krupa, Duke Ellington, Cole Porter, Glenn Miller, Harry James and Tommy Dorsey. The Skylarks and Tommy Dorsey, and Leslie Caron provide the vocals reminiscent of the Pied Pipers with Frank Sinatra.

The Spring Series dances include a buffet dinner, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and the dance itself, from 8:00

p.m. to 12 midnight in the castle library.

Tickets are \$30.00 per person for the dinner and dance package, or \$15.00 per person for the dance only. Reservations for the Big Band Dances may be made by calling the Casa Loma Box Office at 923-1172.

Tickets may be purchased at the door or at the Casa Loma Box Office on Saturday and Sundays only in January and February, as the castle is closed to the public during the week. Casa Loma returns to its regular schedule on March 1st when it will be open seven days a week from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Casa Loma is located at 1 Austin Terrace, near Spadina and Davenport, south of St. Clair Avenue West. There is plenty of free parking.

Florida routings up 15 per cent

The Hamilton Automobile Club reported this week that the number of travel routings requested by Members during the past year totalled over 30,000. This was an increase of 15.5 per cent over the past year.

Despite the high exchange rate, routings for Florida were up 15 per cent still the number one destination in the U.S.A. North and South Carolina were up 7 1/2 per cent, while New York and New England were up 5 per cent.
