Administration-Clerk Joe Simon told council Monday night the application was submitted by G. Vastis for 1.38 acres at Part Lot 15, Con. 8, on the southeast corner of the intersection.

The property is designated both Rural Cluster and Highway Commercial by the Halton Hills Official

Plan. A planning department report is to be submitted to council shortly on the application.

He wants council to curb excessive and unnecessary spending. Mr. Gillespie says he sees less services than in the past and is still waiting for curbs on his road.

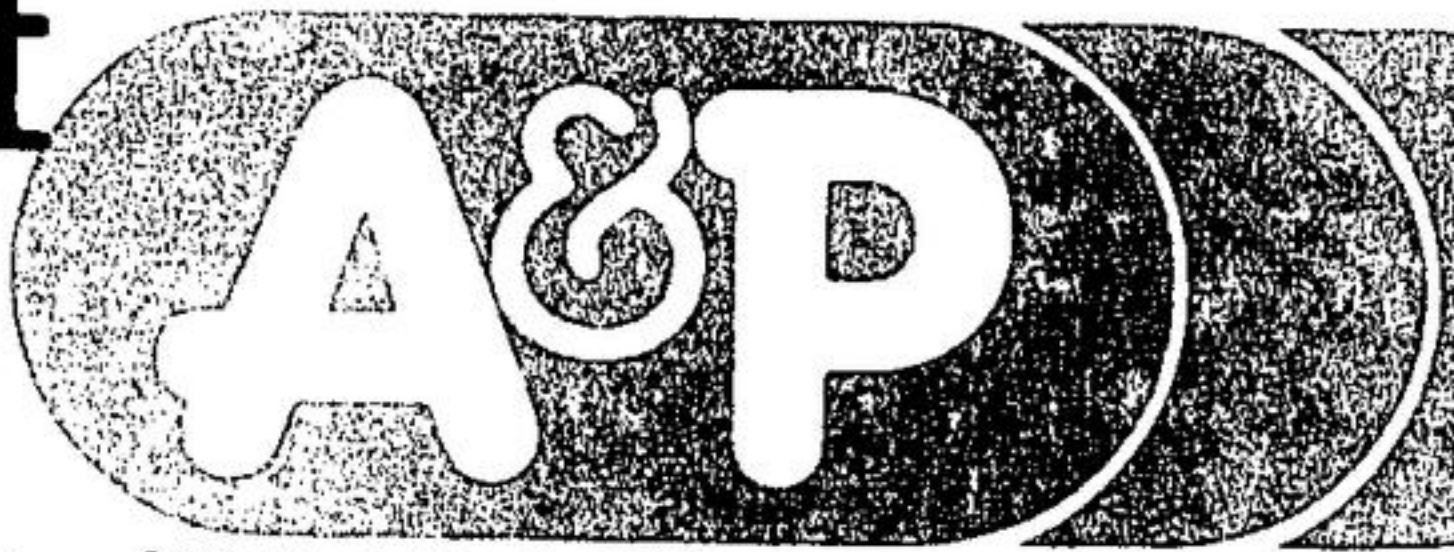
**Gov't week**
