

Tots take to the ice to learn skating basics

Lise Roman, who instructs the group of about 20 tots, paired with their parents, says the program gives the youngsters a chance to try skating with the "support" they re-

"The children have no fear when they're little," Roman says. "It's like any sport. It's easier for them to learn, because they don't realize

And that's the premise on which the Halton Hills Recreation and Parks Department's Parent-Tot skating program works.

The important thing is they learn how to get around on the ice - with the fewest bruises possible.


