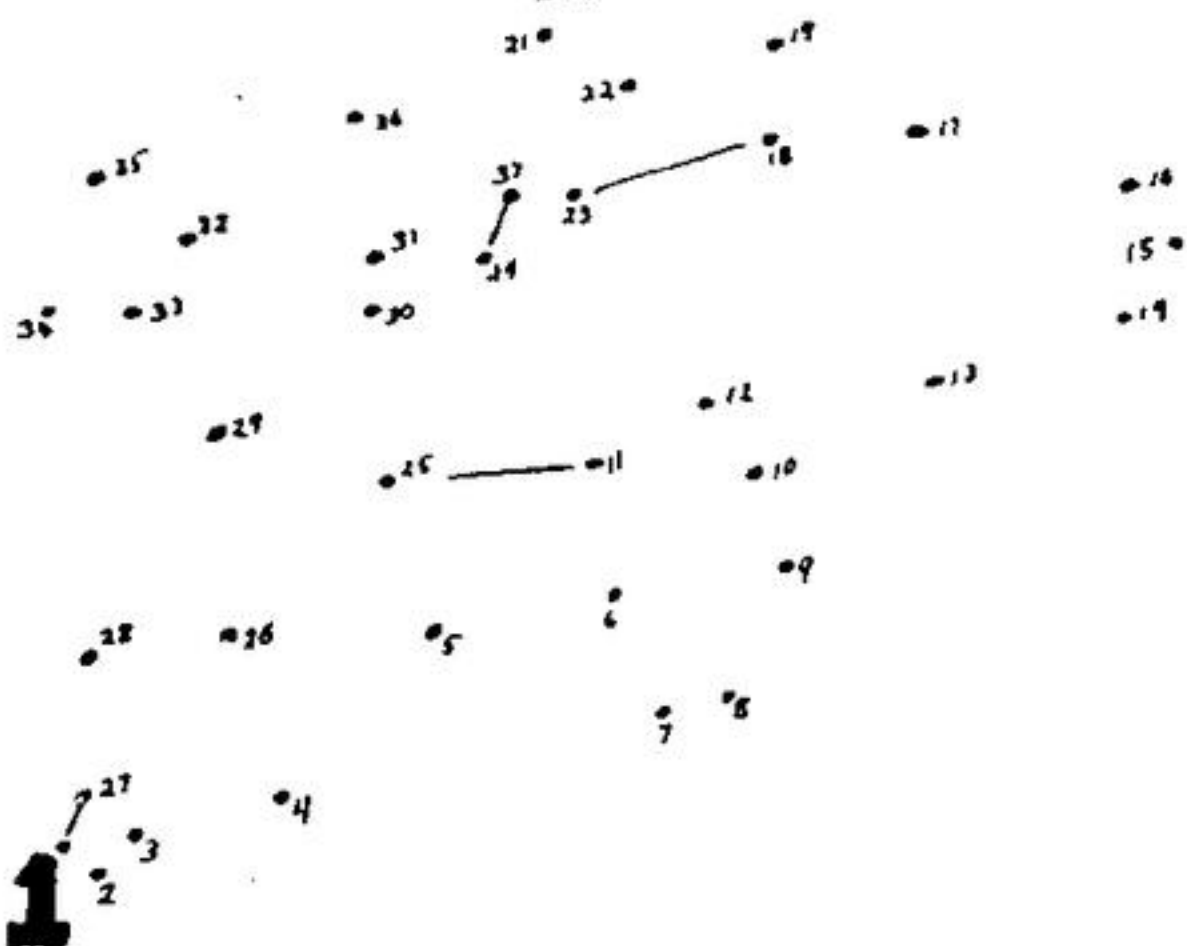


# Young Outlook

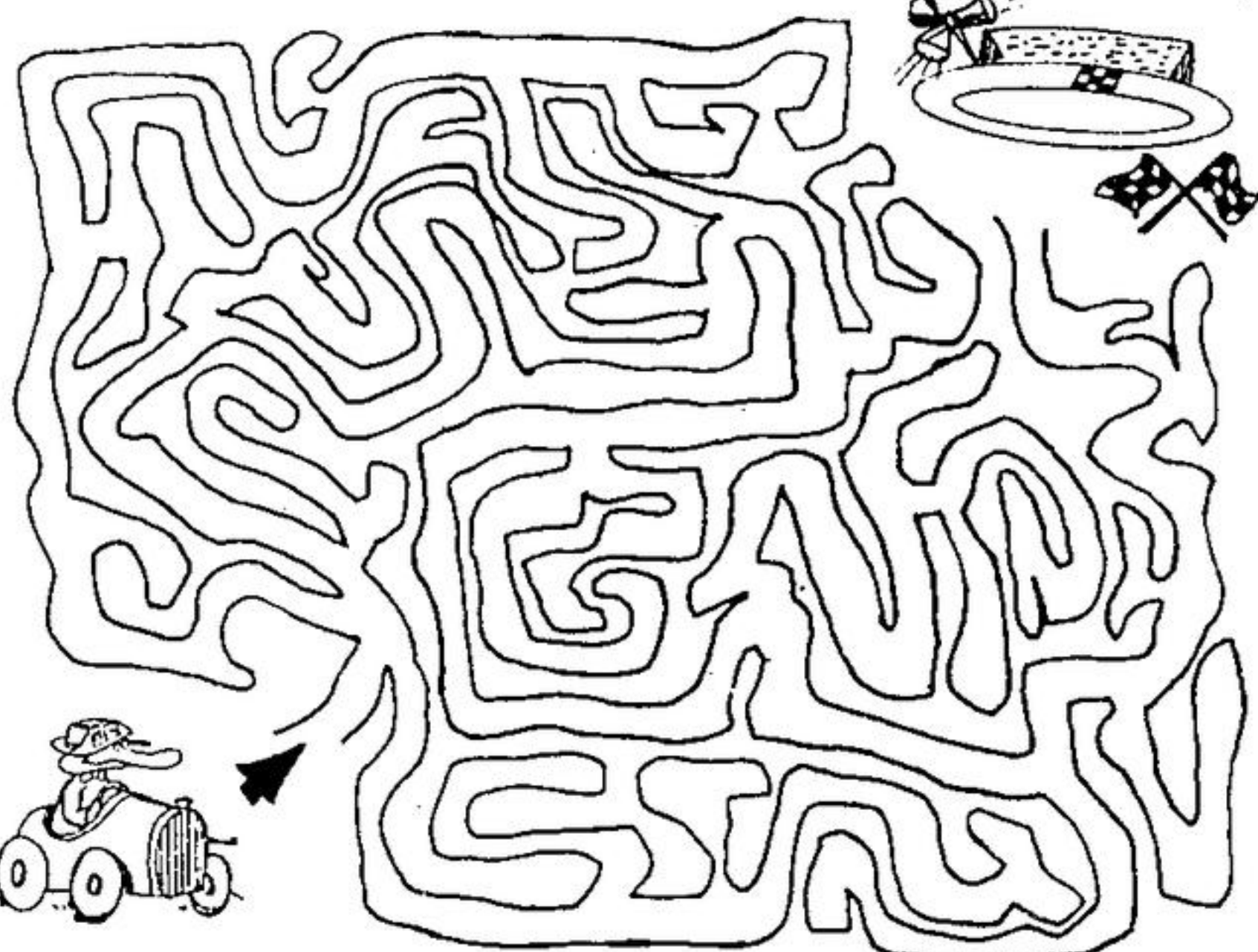
