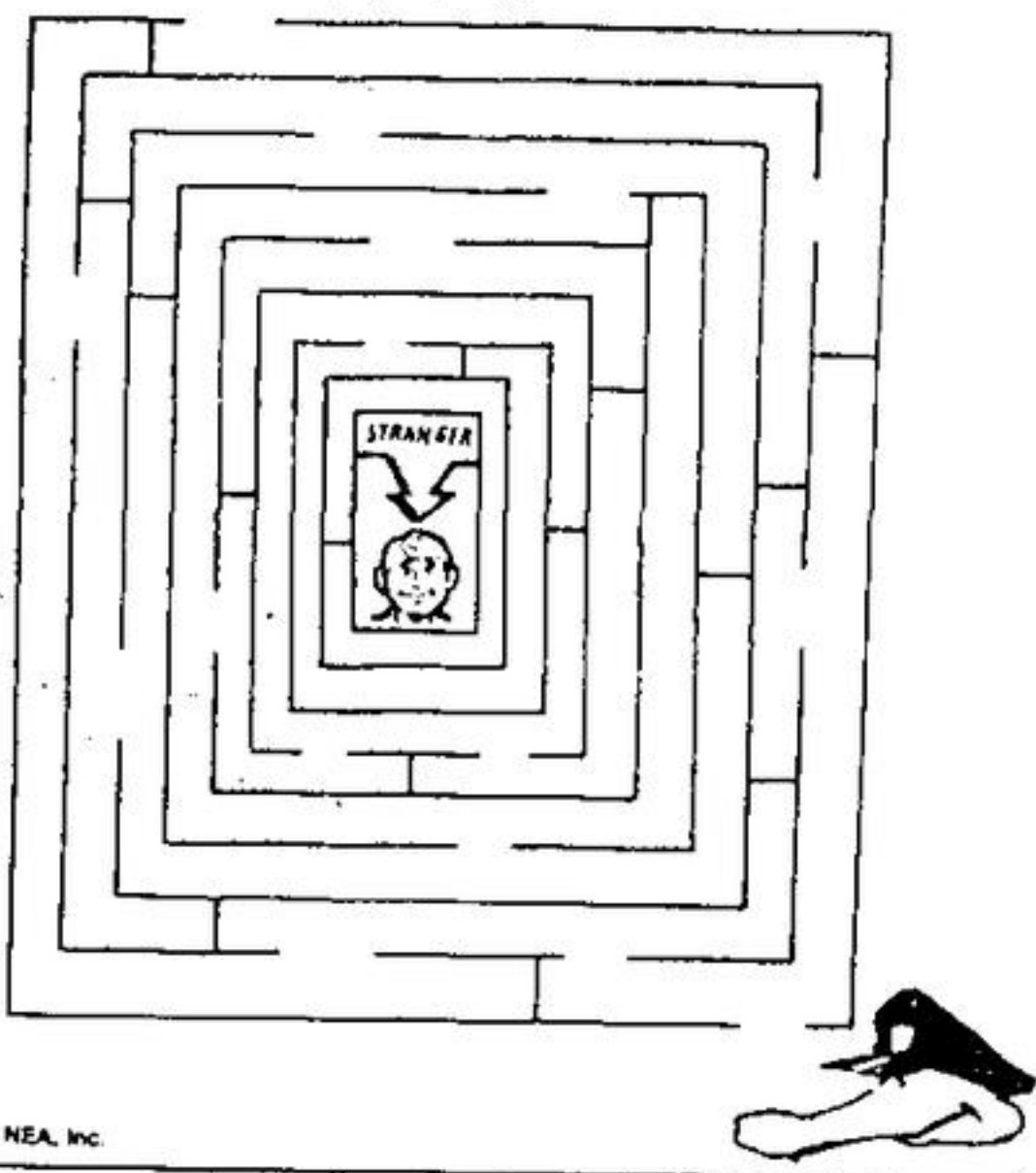

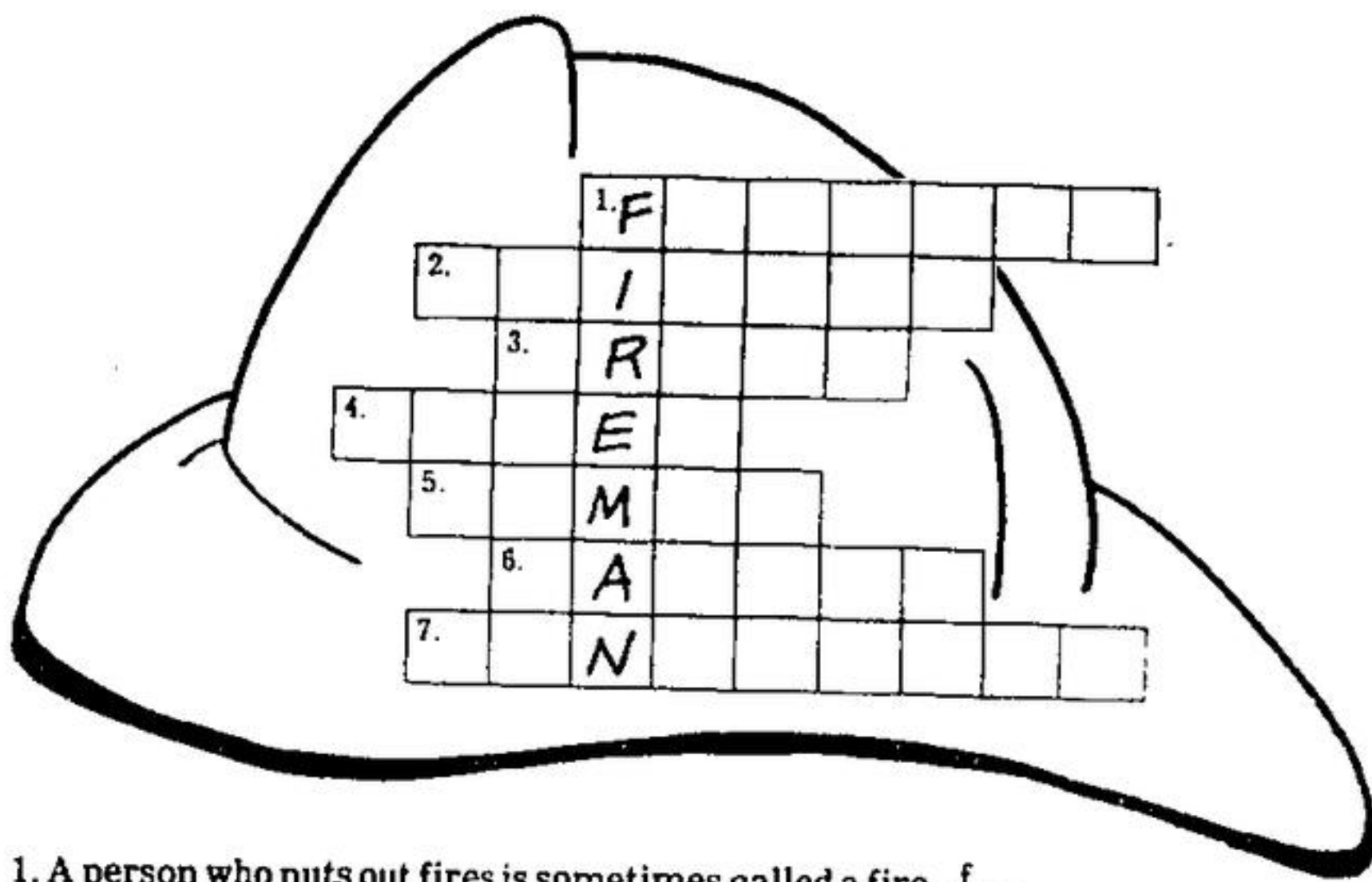
ABSENT ADDRESSES
