Coaching program offers impressive wealth of experience

Speed and Power: The Winning Components will be attended by about 125 prominent experts. The conference, included in a series for Advanced Coaching Development, is just a small part of the high-intensity preparation necessary for the 1988 Olympic Winter Games.

"High-level coaching is the key to optimal performance for Olympic competition says Jack Lynch, Technical Director for the Canadian Olympic Association. "We recognize this and therefore have entered into a partnership with the Coaching Association of Canada to provide a series of advanced coaching seminars."

About 1,500 athletes and 1,100 coaches or related staff will participate in Calgary '88. will share his winning techniques for maximizing athletic performance.

As well, head coach Gerard Mach of track and field and Deryk Snelling of swimming, will share practical information on speed training and motivation.

The conference fee is \$100 which includes theoretical and practical sessions plus information on new athletic products and services.
