You have until April 28 to write the town and air your feelings on zoning changes for a nursery on Sideroad 5 west of Trafalgar Road in

Neighbours to the garden centre turned out at a public meeting last week to state their opposition to the proposal by Tom Moroz.

Cindy Peardon said she's concern-

ed about noise traffic and speeding vehicles on Sideroad 5 increasing because of expansion to the Moroz

business. Hilda Barrack agreed with Mrs

Peardon. Town Deputy Planning Director Bruce McLean said Sideroad 5 is a Regional road designated secondary arterial, which means it is intended to carry higher levels of traffic.

Next door neighbour to Mr. Moroz,
Murray Gregory said he's examined
the proposal and is in favor of it.
"I feel it will be an asset to our
community and am pleased to have such an operation next to my place,"

he said. Mr. Moroz wants the zoning change so that he may sell imported nursery products. He also intends to provide landscaping services to customers. He is a landscape ar-

chitect. "I don't feel traffic will increase. As far as parking, parking is includ-ed inside the property, screened by landscaping," Mr. Moroz said. Planning staff will be bringing a report based on any written submis-

sions they receive and comments made at the public meeting, May 4.


