necessary throughout the season to prevent the ripening of their seeds and dispersal of their pollens, the Town of Halton Hills may enter private property and destroy these weeds. The costs will be charged against the property owners and collected in the manner of municipal taxes.

Goatsbeard, thisties, chicory, polson by, regweed, wild carrot, and milkweed are among the weeds considered noxious, and must be destroyed wherever found. Complaints regarding dandelion and golden rod will not be accepted as these are not considered nixious under the forms of The Weed Control Act.

Anonymous complaints will not be accepted.
