Addition okay

Mr. R. Robinson of Irwin Crescent in Georgetown has had his plans for an addition, a deck and

lot grading approved by the Credit Valley Conservation Authority.

A recent report by Peto MacCallum Ltd. who undertook the study on slope failures on Irwin Crescent shows the slope on Mr. Robinson's backyard is stable and the proposed addition won't affect this stability. The addition is to be 18 feet from the existing top-of-bank, and 37 by 14 feet.

The Authority approval requires detailed construction drawings, and the erection of a snow fence three metres from the top-of-bank.
