CONTRACT P-87-C-2
FOURTH LINE/SEVENTEEN SIDE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION — PHASE 3A

Involving the reconstruction of Seventeen Side Road from approximately 350 metres west of the Sixth Line to the Fifth Line.
