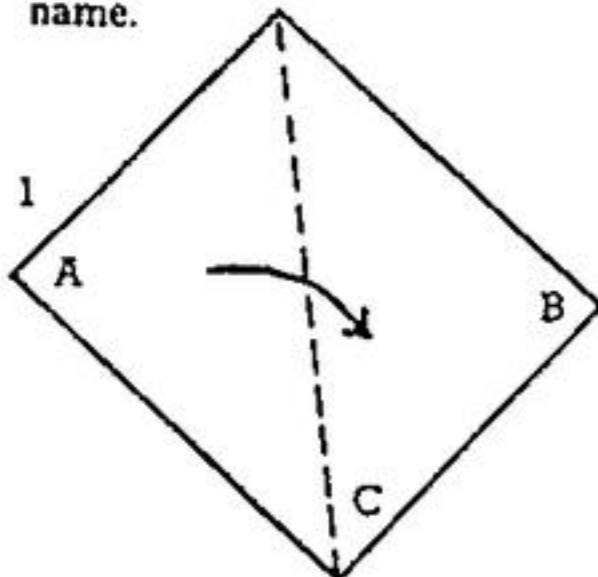
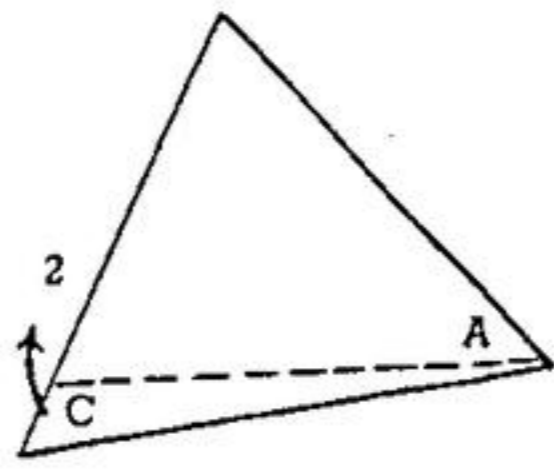


# Young Outlook

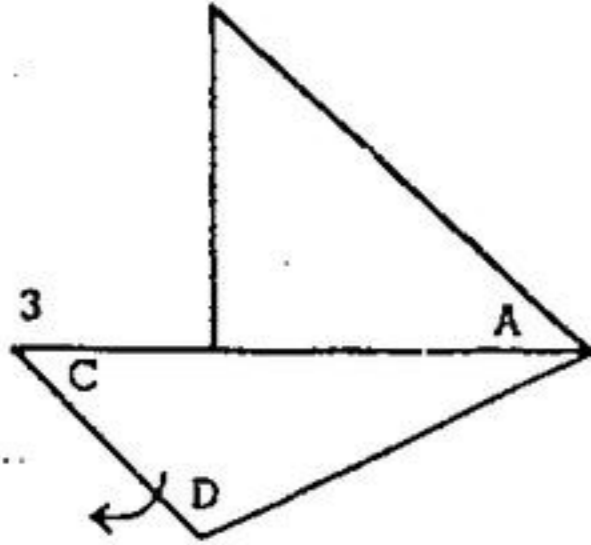

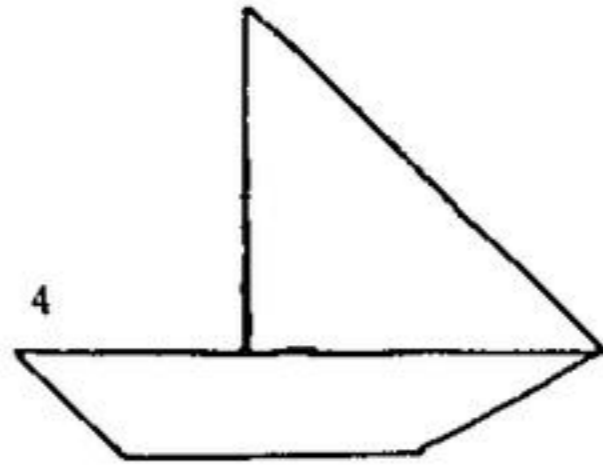
1. Fold the paper over so that corner A rests on corner B. Follow the direction of the arrow. Press down and fold.



2. Fold corner C back so that corner C and corner A make a straight line.



3. Fold under Corner D so that there is a straight line on the bottom of the boat.



4. Now that you have finished, paste your boat on a piece of paper and color the water and sky.

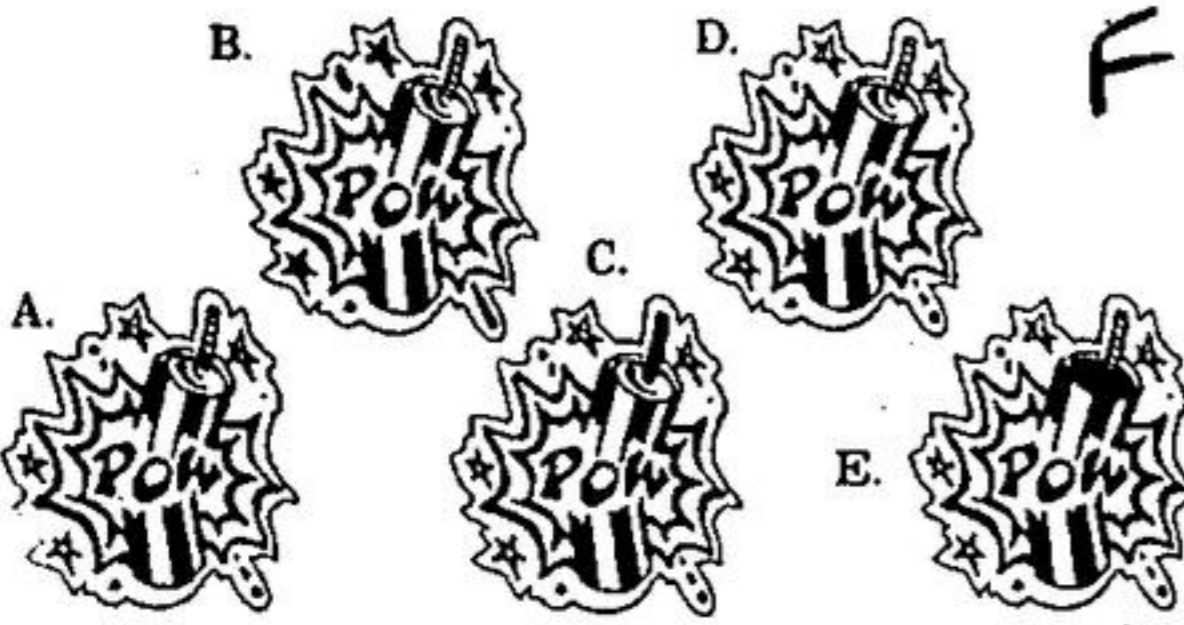

In some places, firecrackers are used as part of the Fourth of July celebrations. Only two of these firecrackers are exactly alike. Circle the two that are alike.

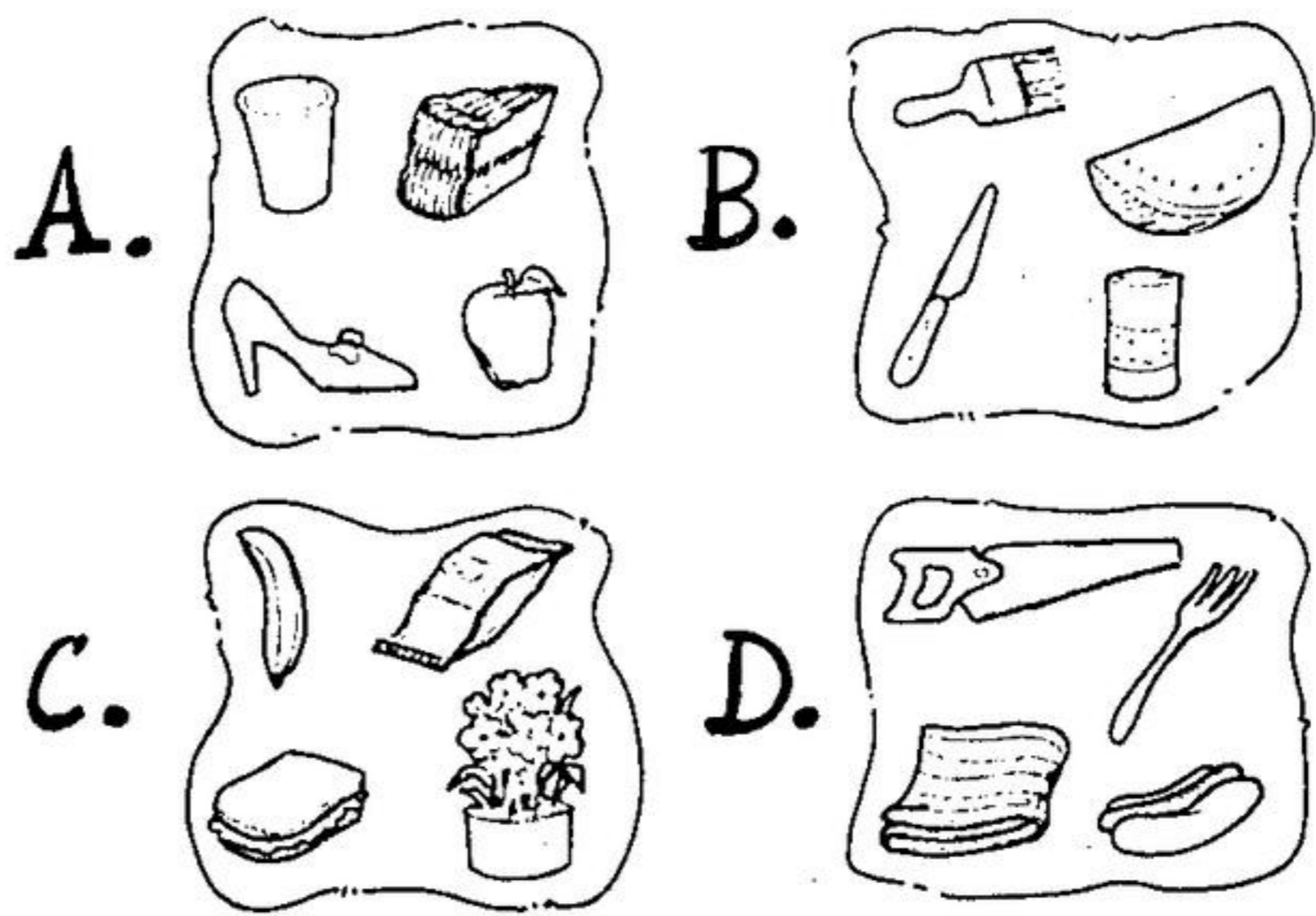

Answers: A: shoe, B: paint brush, C: flowers, D: saw

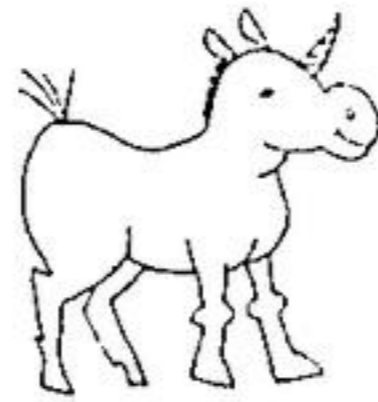

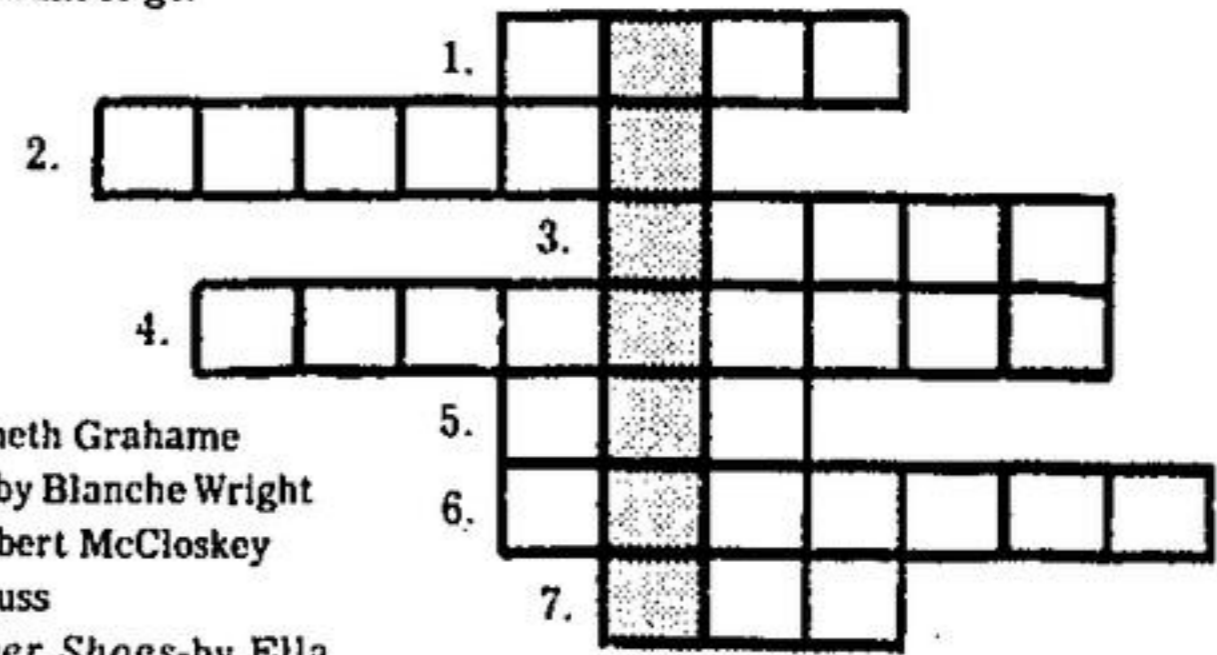
