

Kenworth burns \$100,000 damage

Halton Fire crews answered seven calls last week including a \$100,000 truck fire on Armstrong Avenue.

On June 25 at 3:53 p.m. the fire department answered a car fire call. A late 1970's Thunderbird caught fire causing \$2,000 damage. The fire started in the engine.

At 9:11 p.m. the same day firefighters answered a false alarm on Armstrong Avenue.

Shortly after that firefighters extinguished a rubbish fire at Lot 21,

Concession 7. There was no damage in the fire.

Fire crews received a resuscitator call at 2:14 a.m. at 203 Churchill Road North June 28.

At 10:30 a.m. the fire department received another resuscitator call at Lot 15, Concession 6.

A third resuscitator call was received at 2:52 a.m. at Lot 18, Concession 7.

A 1986 Kenworth was consumed in flames by the time fire crews got to the scene at 36 Armstrong Avenue at 4:51 p.m. June 28.

The truck received \$100,000 damage and the fire department suspects a fire started in the engine area due to a fuel leak.
