Kentners take over third spot

The Kentners, coming off a tough loss to the Midas Top Guns last week came out and put on a strong defensive showing Tuesday night to move into sole possession of third place in the Over 30 Ball Hockey League standings.

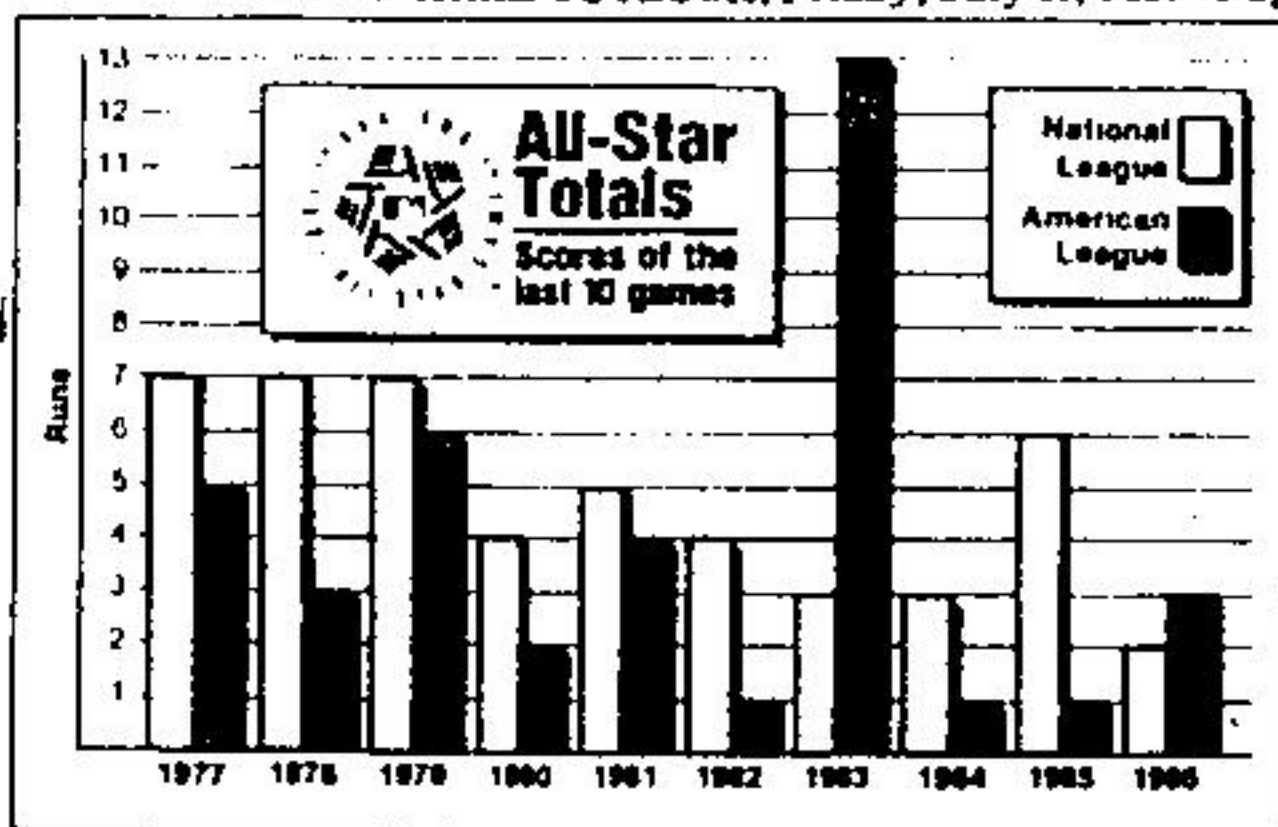
