Easy Riders from town want help to raise cancer funds

The Ninth Annual Motorcycle Ride for Cancer is slated for Aug. 2 and organizers are looking for Georgetown riders to navigate the 250 mile route.

Georgetown area organizers Peter and Betty Bot are riding for the eighth time this year and between them they hope to raise \$2,500.

The ride is organized by the Welland Motorcycle Club but Mr. Bot has been associated with the Welland club since the late 1950's.

Last year some 50 or 60 riders raised between \$5,000 and \$6,000 for cancer research. Mr. Bot hopes to double last year's Georgetown contingent to about 12 riders and he is in order to gain support from Molson's Breweries who will sponsor clubs riding in the event.

The local checkpoint is located at Bracken's Restaurant on Mountainview Road and motorcycle enthusiast Keith Perkins will be on hand to rally the riders.

All the money pledged to the ride goes directly to the Cancer Society as any administration costs are incurred by the riders themselves, Mr. Bot said.

The route, which travels throughout southern Ontario, takes just over six hours to complete "if you don't get lost," Mr. Bot said.

Organizers won't release the route until the day before the event," he said.

Other checkpoints are expected to be located in Welland and Brantford, Mrs. Bot said.

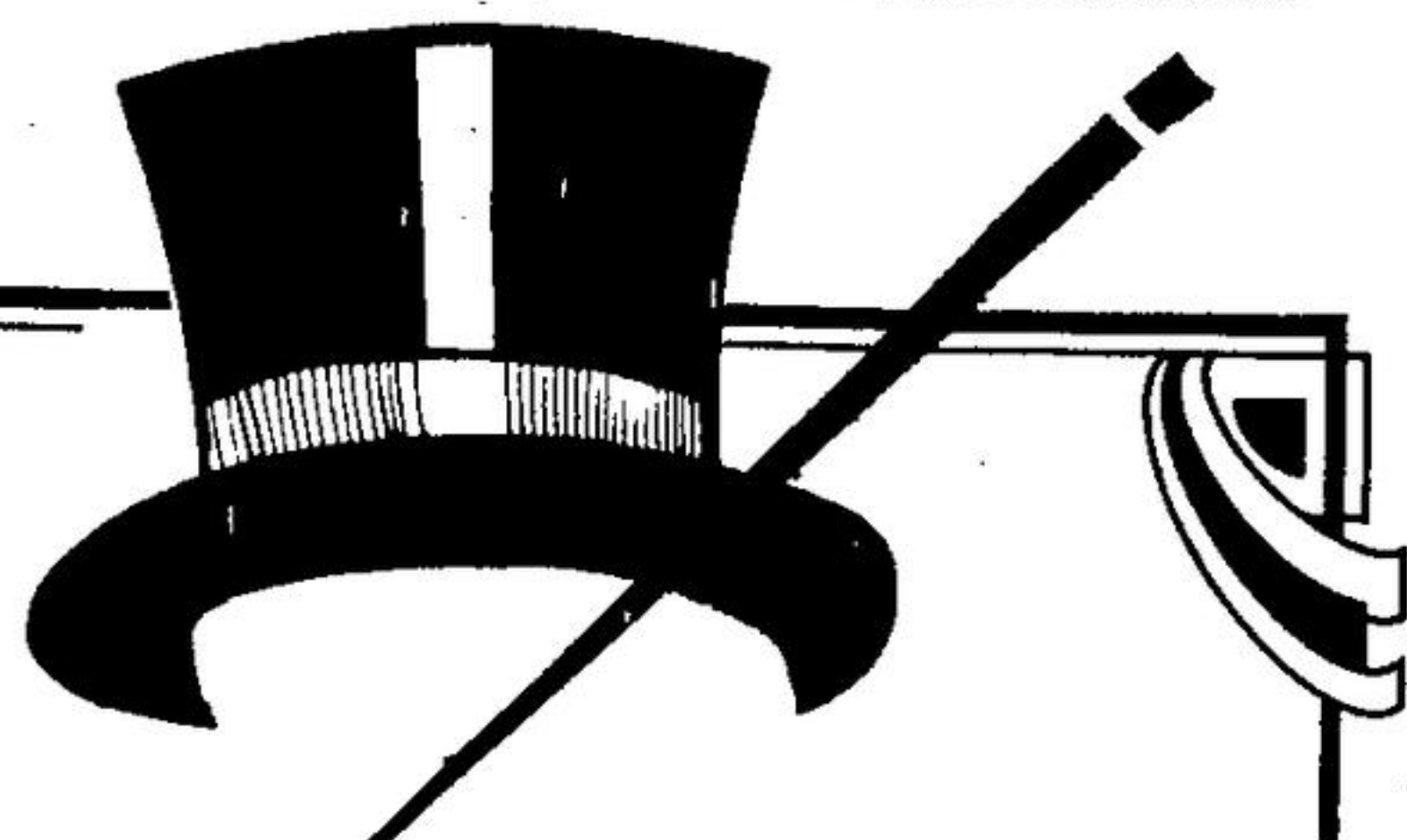
