# Town votes against parking ban

Motorists will still be able to park their cars on the south side of Pennington Crescent east of Mountainview Road despite attempts by local residents to have parking prohibited on that stretch of road.

Town council passed a bylaw in January prohibiting parking on the north side of Pennington Crescent near Mountianview Road. Councillors felt the number of driveway entrances, the horizontal curve alignment of the road east of Mountianview Road and the amount of pedestrians on the road warranted the parking ban.

The parking ban was temporary pending a report. But Mr. A.O. Blencowe, of 6 Pennington Crescent, appealed to councillors Oct. 14 to prohibit parking on both sides of Pennington Crescent at the curve in the road,

Cars parked on the south side tends to create a blind spot at the curve and Mr. Blencow says that creates a dangerous situation.

"We only need one accident. We all feel that its always there to happen," Mr. Blencowe said of the potential for an accident at the

curve.
"I think there should be no parking there at all," he said.

No tickets have been issued for parkig offenders in the north side of the road, Mr. Blencowe said.

"We've never had a ticket in the place. Let's be honest, the police don't want to be bothered with them "he said

them," he said.
"The bend is the original cause of

the whole problem," he said.

Only one accident has occurred on that part of the road since 1981, a report by the town operations engineer said.

Councillor Marilyn Serjeantson wondered if the multiple dwelling units on Pennington are adding to the problem.

Town staff were instructed to prepare a report on parking problems that are created with multiple

dwelling units.

Mayor Russ Miller wondered about tickets not handed out on the street. "We seem to hear that quite often. The police are too lazy," he

He questioned Bylaw Enforceement Officer Bob Ustrzycki about the problem. Mr. Ustrzycki said a report on the possibility of hiring more meter persons is being prepared.
