

# Humor Outlook

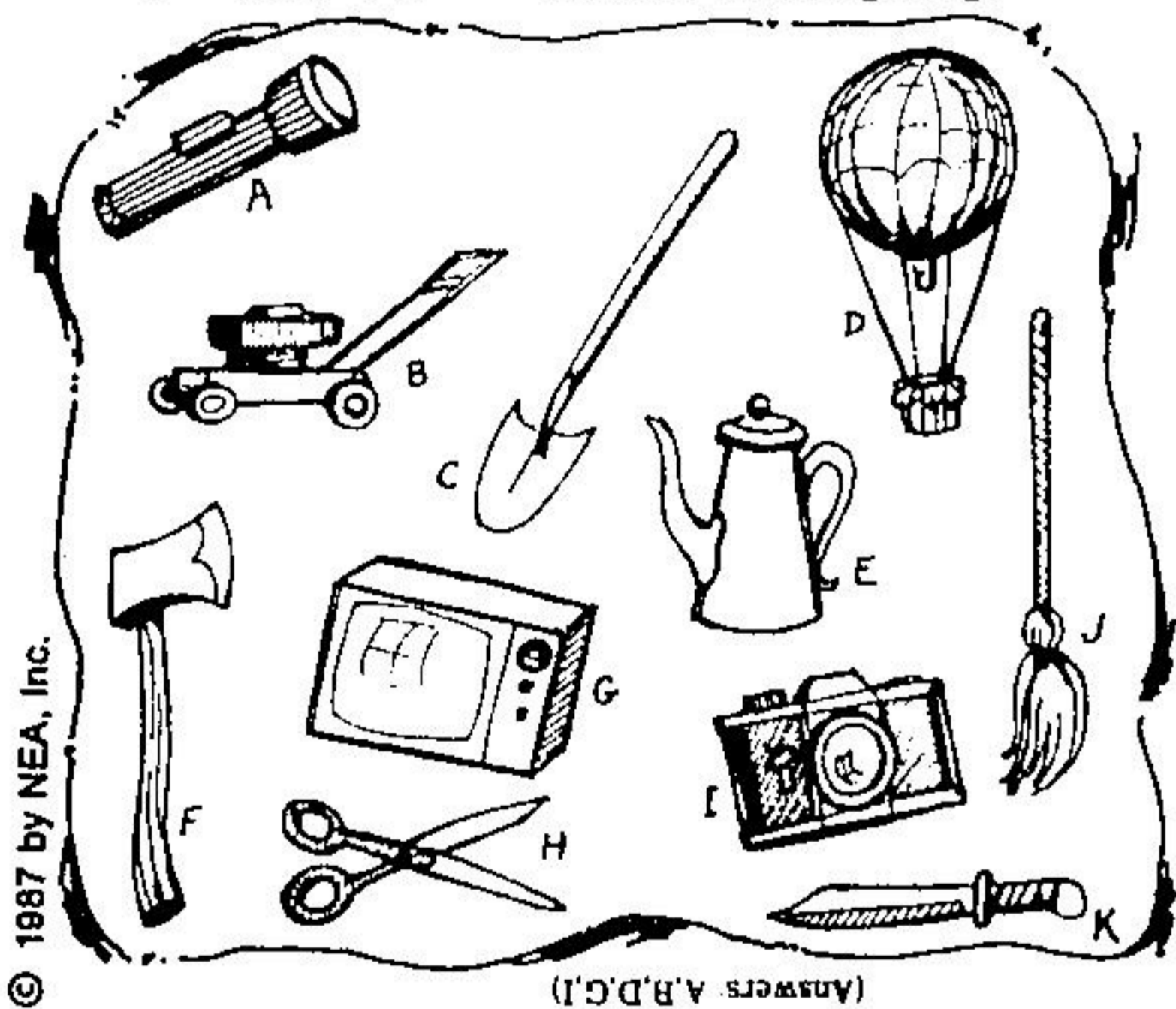

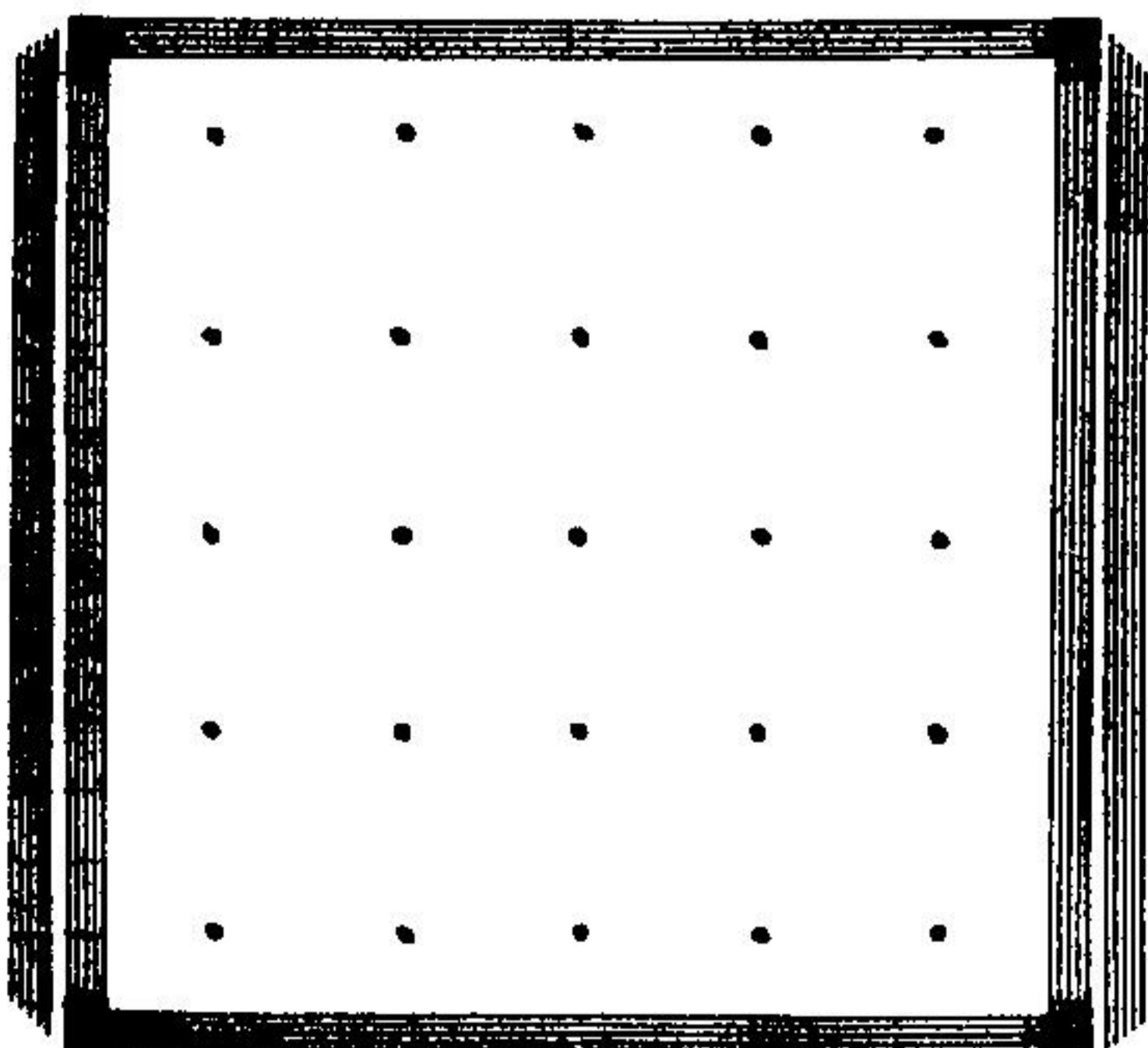

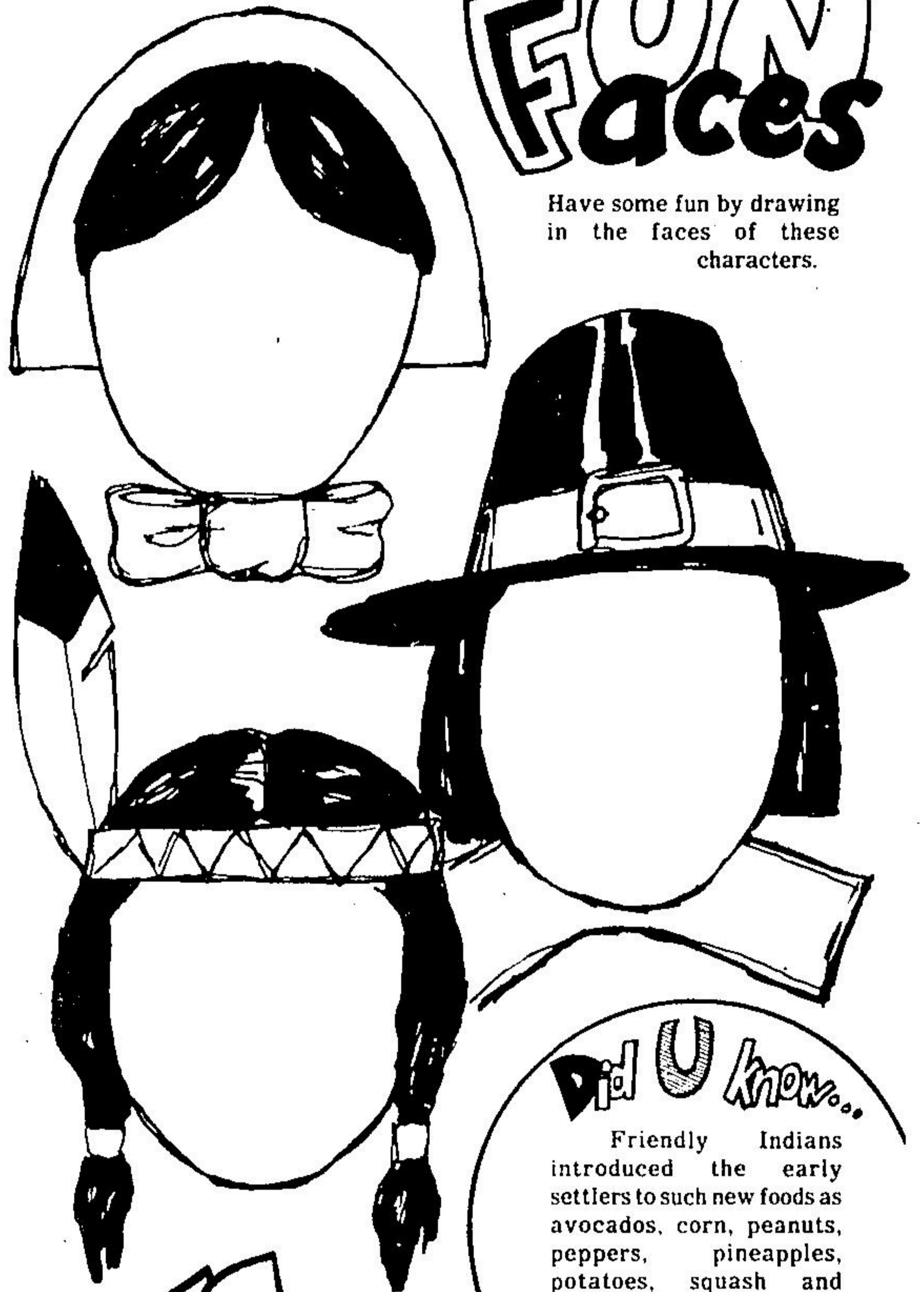


Connect twelve of these dots with straight lines so as to form a perfect cross which has five dots inside it and eight outside.



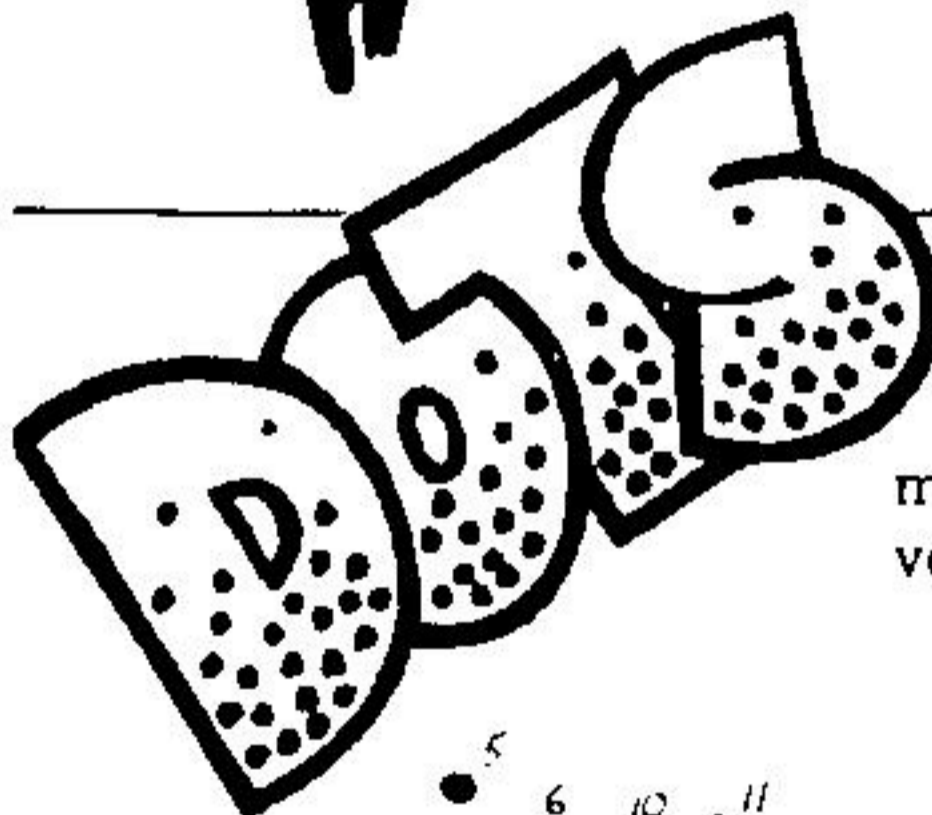
## FUN Faces

Have some fun by drawing in the faces of these characters.

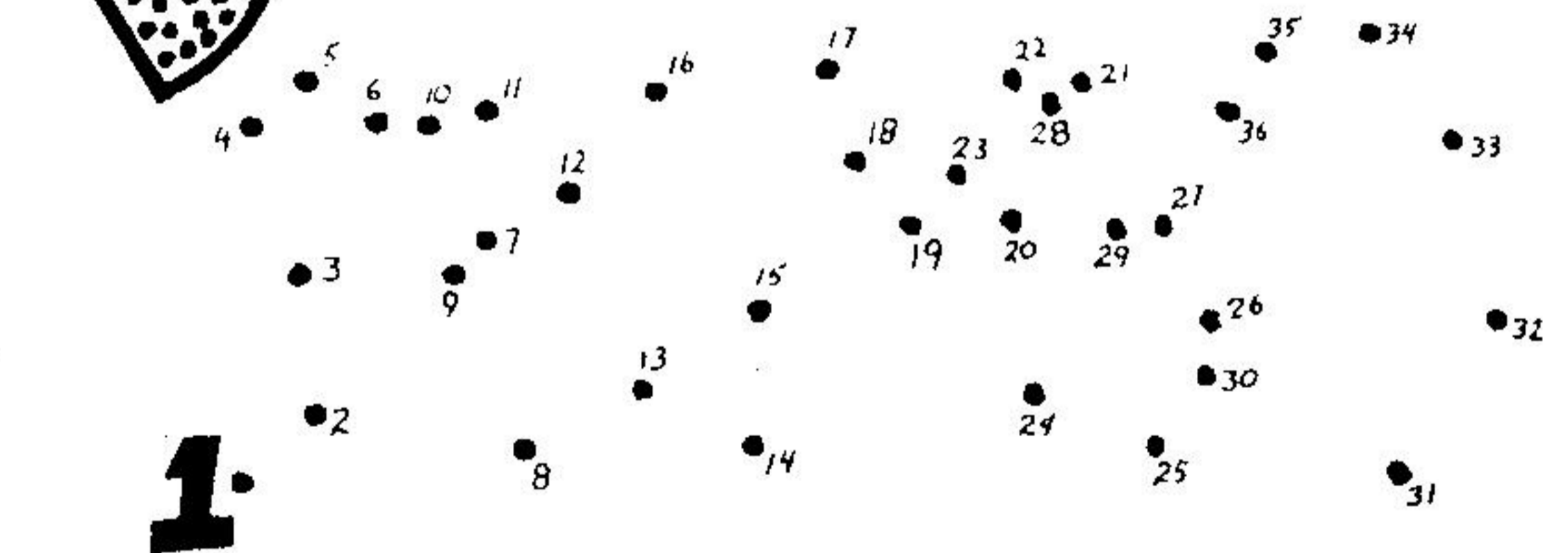


### Did U know..
