If the kitchen area is smaller, a unified, light neutral cofor scheme will give the illusion of pushing the cabinetry into the walls and making the space look larger. Light accent pieces such as pastel accessories will add interest and still maintain. a light and airy appearance.

Another factor in choosing color for the kitchen is the amount of anticipated activity in the area, which will help make choices more obvious. For example, if children will be spending a good amount of time in this room, a more informal selection of materials and tones should be considered.


A more soothing choice in the pastel range or a neutral would create better atmosphere, if appropriate.







