If you want to make specific holiday purchases that don't include skyscraper-priced evening dresses, Einbender recommends these budgetoriented fashion choices:

• For \$300, a beautiful beaded sweater (\$200) and velvet pants or skirt (\$100).

• For \$100, "I hope she has a great black skirt and can buy a beautiful white charmeuse blouse and lurex scarf."

. For \$50, a wide stretch belt and some large dressy earrings.
